CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT LORRAINE F. REGAN

Chief Master Sergeant Lorraine F. Regan is the Command Chief Master Sergeant for the Air National Guard Readiness Center (ANGRC), Joint Base Andrews, Maryland. She is the principal advisor to the ANGRC commander on all enlisted matters. Her responsibilities include keeping the commander informed of all issues affecting the health, morale, welfare, readiness, and proper utilization of enlisted personnel assigned to the ANGRC and its operating locations who serve more than 105,000 Air National Guard Members.

Chief Regan entered the Air Force in 1988 serving as a plumbing specialist. In 1991, she cross trained into the air traffic control career field performing these duties at various units. In 1998, she joined the Air National Guard as a drill status Guardsman. She crossed into the personnel career field and served in this capacity at two Wings until she was mobilized in 2002 to work in the ANGRC's Crisis Action Team Personnel Cell. In 2004, Chief Regan was selected for a statutory tour at the ANGRC working in a variety of positions in the Operations and Manpower, Services and Personnel Directorates. In 2011, Chief Regan served as the Chief Enlisted Manager of the NGB Manpower, Personnel and Services Directorate advising the NGB/A1 Director on matters influencing the health, morale and welfare of assigned enlisted personnel and their families.

Chief Regan served as the Secretary of the Air Force's enlisted lead for Total Force Continuum (TF-C) efforts and the primary enlisted voice

shaping TF-C initiatives. Prior to assuming her current position, Chief Regan was the Special Assistant for Total Force Enlisted Issues at the Pentagon, Arlington, Virginia.
