Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **11XX, 12XX, 13BX, or 16GX**. **Lieutenant Colonels applying for this position must have a minimum of two years time in grade and have completed SDE. Must have a Top Secret Clearance. Lieutenant Colonels must provide copies of all OPRs. Lieutenant Colonels possessing a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) confirmed by the Senate must provide a copy of the NGB/A1 message listing the member's name.** Duties and responsibilities: (Duties and Desired Qualifications) Ensure coordination of critical and time-sensitive crisis management and emergency response information between federal senior management officials, NORAD, CONR, USNORTHCOM, 1AF (AFNORTH) and applicable Air Defense Sectors. To accomplish this coordination, serve as the: Senior CONR/1AF (AFNORTH) representative to the NCRCC. Senior CONR/1AF (AFNORTH) subject matter expert and primary point of contact for NORAD/CONR /1AF (AFNORTH) communications. Supervisor for all NORAD/CONR/1AF (AFNORTH) personnel assigned or attached to TSA/NCRCC. Assist with the development and implementation of approved crisis management policies, recommend strategies, and execute operational decisions with/and under the authority of CONR/1AF (AFNORTH). Represent CONR/1AF (AFNORTH) in designated DOD and interagency conferences, specified task forces, exercises, committees and forums to strategically provide an operational link to other agencies and ensure operational plans are synchronized and integrated with appropriate agencies. Serve as the: CONR/1AF (AFNORTH) liaison/member of the Airspace Protection Working Group. CONR/1AF (AFNORTH) member of the Integrated Homeland Air Security Council. CONR/1AF (AFNORTH) liaison to Joint Theater Air Missile Defense Organization (JTAMDO) for security and defense work on the NCR Demo project CONR/1AF (AFNORTH) /Air Defense Sector representative to planning meetings with SJFHQ-NCR AND 11WG. NORAD/CONR/1AF (AFNORTH) liaison with NORAD/USNORTHCOM Washington Office. Exercise mature judgment and sound diplomacy with the demonstrated ability to manage and adapt during crisis situations characterized by rapidly changing information flows and uncertainty, which may lead to abbreviated and compressed planning processes to provide rapid, timely recommendations and courses of action regarding air and space capabilities. Identify existing and potential problems regarding aviation security activities; and execute a variety of special and sensitive assignments in direct coordination with the TSA COO, NORAD, CONR, 1AF (AFNORTH). Maintain continuous daily situation awareness of transportation systems, intelligence threat reporting, open source news monitoring, event correlation, multi-source fusion of operational and intelligence information and trend analysis, and be able to use this information in both the deliberate and crisis response planning processes. Provide technical advice and assistance, as required, to all entities involved in responding to crisis related transportation security matters and incidents, both national and international. Maintain continuous contact with CONR-1AF

(AFNORTH) Command Section, HQ 1 AFAFFOR senior staff and AOC Director and staff to allow for timely and efficient support of full-spectrum air and space capabilities during crisis management and consequence management. activities. Applicants will include 5 years of evaluations, military or civilian.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-2503, Paragraph 3.4.3

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Members selected for a statutory tour positions MUST provide copies of the last OPR/EPR required—units must complete any CRO or Annual reports due and forward copies to ANG/OMH prior to statutory tour orders being published. IAW AFI 36-2406, TABLE 3.1 LINE 6, NOTE 5(b)(1)(a and b).

- The report is mandatory as a result of pending separation, retirement, or PCS of the rater, or PCS or separation of the ratee, use the date 30 calendar days before the projected departure date, or:
- If the 30-day rule will cause a ratee to be ineligible for a report due to lack of supervision, adjust the close-out to the date within the 30-day window on which 120 days of supervision is achieved.
- To record significant events, the date (within the 30-day window) approved by the commander.
