Duties and Responsibilities: Serves as the MAJCOM Division Superintendent that oversees Cyberspace, Domestic Operations, and Mission Systems Functional Area Management functional area management and certification programs related to Base Communications, Combat Communications and Engineering and Installation missions sets including Readiness, Career Field Management, Missions Systems integration, and emerging opportunities in the Cyberspace domain. Incumbent should be a seasoned professional in Cyberspace, Communications and Information, and Domestic Operations with depth and experience commensurate to interact with Commander, Air National Guard Readiness Center, Director of Staff, and Director. Oversees readiness, force management policies and programs, contingency planning and deployment compliance with SAF, AFSPACE, and USCYBERCOM directives. Incumbent should have thorough knowledge of Cyberspace, Domestic Operations, Mission Systems, and Communications and Information

Technology mission areas and be able to manage a highly diverse, technically savvy workforce. Highly desired to have an overall knowledge of DoD, USAF, ANG structure, missions, programs, policies, and organizational relationships. Performs as an Air National Guard Communications and Information Technology subject matter expert and serves as a senior enlisted A6C representative to NGB Joint Staff, Headquarters Air Force and the MAJCOM A6s. Performs Daily staff management, NGB tasker support; delivers briefings and presentations to senior officers at NGB, Air Staff and MAJCOM Headquarters. Incumbent should possess superb interpersonal and communicative skills, both oral and written; have the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships, and negotiate effectively and professionally. Assists in the development of ANG standards, policy, plans, and objectives responding to new and existing processes and requirements as established by the United States Air Force, National Guard Bureau, and Department of Defense. Ensures current and future requirements solutions comply with Federal, DoD and Air Force guidelines. Provides oversight, supervision, and career development to assigned cyberspace enlisted professionals. Oversees, advises, and executes all staff personnel actions and programs. Mentors and councils all enlisted personnel assigned.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-25-03, Paragraph 3.4.3.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.
