Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-4 year Statutory Tour at **TEC (McGhee Tyson, TN)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **ANY**. Duties and Responsibilities: Must have completed NCOA and SrNCOA in-residence or via correspondence, in -residence is highly desirable. Bachelor degree is highly desirable, but Must have a minimum of an associate degree.

Lead, directs, implements and oversees the Mission Support Division of the I.G. Brown Training and Education Center. Overall responsibility for the management, supervision and training of personnel assigned to the Commander Support Staff, Campus Operations and Information Technology Branches. Primary advisor, implementer and coordinator to the TEC Commander, Division Chiefs and outside agencies on all matters relating to support requirements for the TEC mission. Extensive leadership and management background demonstrated with excellent written and oral communications is required. Broad basic knowledge of military personnel and training, logistics and supply, finance and information technology is desired. Minimum five years demonstrated senior-level leadership is highly desirable.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-25-03, Paragraph 3.4.3.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

Application for this MVA signifies agreement to the following statement, in accordance with (IAW) Title 18 USC 1001: “I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, all of the information on an attached to this application is true, correct, complete and made in good faith.
