Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **ANY**. **Please provide statement of willing to obtain 81T0 AFSC. Must include a official photo. Must complete Academic Instructor School within one year of assignment.** Duties and Responsibilities: Have a working knowledge in communication studies, leadership, management, human behavior, and military training. Prior experience with officer accessions programs highly desirable. Prior teaching experience is desirable. Responsible for helping to formulate training policies, coordinating, monitoring, and executing all education and training activities for AMS officer candidates. Directly involved in creation of curriculum for AMS and evaluation of program effectiveness. Responsible for the construction and continuing revision of objective tests utilized within AMS. Analyzes test questions submitted by instructors to determine suitability for intended use, ease of administration and scoring, misleading or ambiguous terminology, overlapping items with clues to answers, and similar deficiencies. Reviews course learning objectives, study guides, and lesson plans to insure proposed test items track with course materials as well as maintains appropriate levels of learning. Consults with appropriate instructors on deficiencies noted, and recommends revisions as needed. Insures finalized tests include an equitable distribution of items as compared to actual subject matter platform hours and as relates to ease/difficulty index.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-25-03, Paragraph 3.4.3.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.
