Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-4 year Statutory Tour at US CYBER COMMAND (**Ft Meade, MD**). Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **1XX3/4**. **Must have Top Secret Clearance and able to pass CI Polygraph**. Duties and Responsibilities: The NG Advisor to US CYBER COMMAND works for the US CYBER COMMAND Commander and the NG Assistant to the Commander and is responsible for advising Chief, NGB and the Directors of the ARNG and ANG, the Commander, US CYBER COMMAND (USCC), and their respective staffs, on cyber policies, readiness, and other emerging cyber issues affecting NG organizations. The mission of USCC/CG is to evaluate and develop the proper NG force presentation of cyber capabilities, through the components, to meet war fighter requirements of a well trained & organized Total Force. The USCC/CG also serves as the Guard Reserve Director (GRD) leading a joint team of cyber experts from each service in developing a total reserve component presentation of cyber capabilities for USCC. Additionally, the USCC/CG provides full-time support for the Joint Cyber Reserve Unit (JCRU) which manages the part-time reserve component billets assigned to USCC. Other primary duties include participation in the development, review and administering of policies, roadmaps, and programs effecting the mission, size, location, organization, distribution, mobilization, equipping and utilization of NG resources for emerging, aligned or assigned forces to USCC.

Preferred skills/abilities/knowledge: Technical background in either; Network Warfare, Information Operations, Information Technology/Communications, Intelligence, or Space to adequately represent NGB equities at USCC. Staff experience at NGB and Joint Staff or higher. In-depth knowledge and understanding of NG force structure, directives, policies and procedures. Experience in strategic planning, the Planning Programming and Budgeting, and Execution System (PPBES). Command experience at the squadron or above level.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-25-03, Paragraph 3.4.3.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

Application for this MVA signifies agreement to the following statement, in accordance with (IAW) Title 18 USC 1001: "I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, all of the information on an attached to this application is true, correct, complete and made in good faith.
