Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-3 year Statutory Tour at **EUCOM/ECJ5 -SCP (Stuttgart, Germany)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **ANY; Must be able to obtain 16RX AFSC. Must have or be able to obtain Top Secret**. Duties and Responsibilities: Serves as the regional program manager for direct development and execution of security cooperation program events for EUCOM. Provides guidance in the development and planning of country specific events in support of US EUCOM's Theater Strategy and Campaign Plan. Serves as a liaison officer for US EUCOM to include US Air Forces in Europe, US Army Europe, Marine Forces Africa, US Naval Forces Europe, and Special Operations Command Europe. Supports and coordinates National Guard participation in the State Partnership Program. On order, deploys to augment or provide support to security cooperation events in Europe. Coordinates and provides all training, administrative and logistical support for Bi-lateral Affairs Officers (BAO) assigned to participating countries. This includes hosting and conducting annual and newly assigned BAO training conferences.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-25-03, Paragraph 3.4.3.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

Application for this MVA signifies agreement to the following statement, in accordance with (IAW) Title 18 USC 1001: “I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, all of the information on an attached to this application is true, correct, complete and made in good faith.
