Headquarters ANG Title 10 4-year Statutory Tour at **NGB/A3 (Joint Base Andrews, MD)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **2S071**. Duties and Responsibilities: Facilitate supply and support equipment issues of units in conversion. ANG POC responsible for ensuring satisfactory completion of site survey and SATAF action items related to the supply of new equipment. Provide guidance to unit level supply managers in the unique aspects of conversion/activation requirements. It requires an experienced Supply Craftsman who has extensive knowledge and experience in all functions of base supply, with emphasis on equipment and spares requisitioning to include avionics, life support, SPRAMS, RSP, Bench Stock, AGE and ISSL procedures. Should also have a working knowledge of resource management and the fundamentals of supporting GSUs. Should be familiar with the functions and organization of the Air National Guard and the command relationship with USAF, MAJCOMs, NAF, and TAGs. Incumbent should be familiar with MAJCOM procedures, policy and supply requirements and have a working knowledge of MAJCOM, NGB, and USAF regulations and publications applicable to the Air National Guard, HQ, TAC, NAFs, TAGs, and ANG units (to include technician service). Knowledge of resource management and a background in other ANG missions or activities is desirable. Highly desired knowledge in all areas of supply policies and procedures, Air Force property accounting, stock and inventory control, accountability and responsibility, principles of property accounting, logistics principles and interactions (supply, maintenance, transportation, and procurement), and supply deployments or contingency operations. Works full-time analysis and coordination of supply and support equipment site survey and SATAF action items, providing documentation and validation to Conversion Financial Plans (Fin Plans) for those units identified by conversion.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-25-03, Paragraph 3.4.3.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

REGAF Officers IAW AFI 36-2005 Table 2.2 item 27 are not authorized to apply if they have over 18 years TAFMS.
