Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-4 year Statutory Tour at **NGB/A3 (JOINT BASE ANDREWS, MD)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **ANY. MUST BE ABLE TO OBTAIN TOP SECRET SCL**. Duties and Responsibilities: The incumbent functions as a primary liaison for the ANG with Congressional staff, DOD agencies, MAJCOM offices, and operational field units concerning management and policy matters pertaining to ANG c-NAF Augmentation programs and activities. The incumbent acts as the point of contact and facilitator for issues involving ANG operational c-NAF activities. On behalf of the ANG, the incumbent monitors, manages, and makes contributions to the development of tactical weapons, weapons systems and tactics pertaining to the c-NAF mission areas. The incumbent should be able to make judgmental decisions regarding a wide diversity of space, intelligence, surveillance, reconnaissance, information operations, and command and control activities that reside within an AOC as well as a broad understanding of the support functions and activities performed by the AFFOR; an extensive knowledge/background in each mission area operations is essential. Familiarity with a broad crosssection of AFSCs is expected. Oversees program and policy functional management control over c-NAF programs. Should set program priorities, initiates and coordinates actions to satisfy field requirements, gives advice, counsel and instruction. Prepares background briefs, assessments, point papers, and items of interest for ANG staff on current c-NAF programs and activities. ANG POC for issues involving c-NAF training, exercises, inspections, security, systems acquisition, manpower, deployments, conferences, and awards programs.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

Application for this MVA signifies agreement to the following statement, "I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, all of the information on an attached to this application is true, correct, complete and made in good faith.
