Headquarters ANG Title 10 3 year Statutory Tour at **NGB-PA (Arlington, VA)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **35P3/4**. Duties and Responsibilities: Plans, develops, coordinates and administers Public Affairs and Strategic Communications programs to ensure public understanding of national defense, civil support and NGB community outreach missions. Disseminate information on NGB programs, projects and actions. Serve as an expert in public affairs guidance, conduct security reviews of information flow from PA to NGB, all 54 states and territories. Advise supervisors and commanders on public affairs activities. Answer inquiries from motion picture and television industry on NGB, citizen-soldiers and airmen, Title 10, Title 32, Active Duty, uniform wear, etc. Participate or conduct special events.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement. Promotable means that all requirements; rank, TIG, TIS, PME, etc have been completed for advancement to the next higher grade. By close out date you must be eligible to pin on the next higher grade.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

REGAF Officers IAW AFI 36-2005 Table 2.2 item 27 are not authorized to apply if they have over 18 years TAFMS.
