Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-3 year Statutory Tour at **NGB/J3PR (ARLINGTON, VA)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **65F3/4**. Duties and Responsibilities: The primary mission work is to facilitate the prioritization and successful defense of all resources to support NGB-J3/7 programs, goals and objectives achieving a balance between competing requirements. Incumbent must ensure that advice, recommendations and information provided to senior NGB, Air Force and Army leaders, DoD, and Congress are consistent with Defense, Army and Air Force priorities, policies, procedures, and program goals. The alternate mission is to support the classified NMCC as a National Guard action officer on joint team cells for contingency, national event, natural disaster or other coordinated crisis management activities. Oversees and coordinates work for team members based on priorities, taking into consideration the difficulty and requirements of the tasks, capabilities of employees and areas of assignments of each individual. Responsible for the continual design, maintenance and updating of the NGB MDEPs and ANG programs. Reviews the current MDEPs and ANG programs to ensure that the current organization provides the most effective construct for the orderly and equitable distribution of resources. Respond to planned and short notice taskings as National Guard Domestic Operations action officer to crisis management response teams within the NMCC.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.
