Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-4 years Statutory Tour at **1AF/A3 (Tyndall AFB, FL)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC): **11F3/4X. API 8. Must have or be able to obtain a Top Secret Clearance.** Duties and Responsibilities: Individual will work in the Contingency Action Team (CAT) as an Operations Officer, and if required, as part of the AFNORTH Air Component Coordination Element (ACCE) in support of CONPLANs 3400, 3500, and 3501. This position requires daily interface with NORAD-USNORTHCOM, ACC, ANG, as well as a multitude of other agencies to assist Continental United States NORAD Region (CONR) Commander in responding to a variety of crisis in the NORAD-USNORTHCOM area of responsibility (reference CONPLANs 3310, 3400, 3500, 3501). The individual will directly observe and contribute to all operations in support of Operation NOBLE EAGLE (ONE). Individual is also responsible for reviewing Commander CONR directives as they relate to aerospace control in the United States. Individual will be a current and qualified fighter instructor pilot with significant air-to-air and air-to-ground experience. Individual will have daily interface with fighter unit alert personnel and MAJCOM action officers as individual evaluates the training, equipping, and employment of fighter units aligned to or tasked by CONR-1AF(AFNORTH). -Individual will implement and monitor the Stan/Eval program at the NAF level. The individual will daily apply tactics to real-world strategic air defense, national air sovereignty, and counterdrug missions with fighter aircraft. The individual is responsible for reviewing Commander 1AF(AFNORTH) and AFNORTH/A3 fighter weapons and flying policies, procedures, and guidance to ANG, AFRC, and Active Duty fighter wings (reference Operation NOBLE EAGLE EXORD, USNORTHCOM CONPLAN 3400 and NORAD CONPLAN 3310). Performs other duties assigned.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.
