Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-4 years Statutory Tour at **AMC/A4 (Scott AFB, IL)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **2AX9/00**. Duties and Responsibilities: Serves as liaison and program manager on any/all maintenance management issues, with special emphasis on strategic/tactical aircraft, related to ANG/ANGRC affairs and the HQ AMC Director of Logistics. Monitors all aspects of maintenance activities engaged in planning, repairing, and servicing strategic/tactical aircraft and support equipment. Plans, organizes, and manages maintenance activities for repair of aircraft AMC-gained ANG maintenance forces. Provides liaison assistance on maintenance management matters between AMC and the National Guard Bureau (NGB) in the discharge of gaining command responsibilities. Supplies ANG maintenance advisory assistance to functional staff agencies throughout the directorate and the AMC Staff. Is maintenance management advisor/focal point for planning and coordinating logistical activities as they pertain to AMC-gained ANG units. Provides technical guidance concerning ANG maintenance procedures, requirements, and limitations. Monitors and keeps AMC Staff and ANG Advisor to Director of Logistics apprised on status of ANG unit conversions. Actively participates in AMC/ANG conversion efforts on all logistical matters. Ensures/monitors maintenance readiness of AMC-ANG gained ANG resources. Participated in general inspections, ORIs, and audit reports as they affect AMC-gained units to determine the adequacy of corrective action taken. Studies data and conducts studies and or actions to resolve maintenance problem areas affecting the ANG. Keeps AMC staff abreast of happenings, problems and resolutions. Monitors strategic/tactical maintenance, evaluates training requirements and corresponding training opportunities. Sources ANG forces to support active Air Force programs and requirements. Represents NGB at conferences, workshops, scheduling meetings and briefings at HQ AMC and NAF units. Maintains liaison between HQ AMC, NGB, USAF, NAFs and other concerned agencies in regard to the ANG units to be gained upon mobilization. Provides recommendations to exercise section for deployment and employment of strategic/tactical airlift units in OCONUS operations.

Represents HQ AMC as the Guard strategic/tactical weapon system maintenance expert at HQ AMC/NAF conferences, scheduling meetings, and workshops.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-2503, Paragraph 3.8.

Application for this MVA signifies agreement to the following statement, "I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, all of the information in and attached to this application is true, correct, complete and made in good faith. I understand that false or fraudulent information on or attached to this application may be grounds for rejection or for release from statutory tour after I begin work, and may be punishable by fine or imprisonment.
