Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-4 years Statutory Tour at **AMS/DO (Maxwell AFB, AL)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **81T0** or **ANY**. **If the applicant does not already possess the 81T0 AFSC, then the individual must: Provide a statement of understanding with the application stating they will retrain into 81T0 within one year. Application package must include an official photo.** Duties and Responsibilities: Must possess a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university and have completed appropriate level PME for grade and time in service. Applicants must complete Academic Instructor School within one year of assignment. Have a working knowledge in communication studies, leadership, management, human behavior, and military training. Prior teaching experience is desirable. Responsible for effective implementation of the Academy of Military Science (AMS) education and training activities. Supervises up to 20 students. Counsels students on a broad range of topics including academic or military deficiencies, personal problems, progress in AMS, and human relations. Evaluates and relates student potential to serve effectively as a commissioned officer. Critiques field leadership, oral and written exercises, and drill performance. Provides written summary and recommendations of all counseling. Facilitates group discussions and problem solving activities. Responsible for helping to formulate training policies, coordinating, monitoring, and executing all education and training activities for Air National Guard Officer Training School officer candidates. Directly involved in creation of curriculum for AMS and evaluation of program effectiveness.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-2503, Paragraph 3.8.

Application for this MVA signifies agreement to the following statement, "I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, all of the information in and attached to this application is true, correct, complete and made in good faith. I understand that false or fraudulent information on or attached to this application may be grounds for rejection or for release from statutory tour after I begin work, and may be punishable by fine or imprisonment.
