Headquarters ANG Title 10 3 years Statutory Tour at **NGB/LL (Pentagon ADM, VA)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) ANY. *Must have two years TIG as a Maj by close out date of this MVA. Duties and Responsibilities: One year legislative affairs experience is highly desired. Supports NGB/LL in executing senior leadership visits with Congressional offices. Acts as a conduit between Congressional staff and the Department of Defense, and the Air National Guard. Prepares senior ANG leadership on issues impacting Air National Guard's budget, current plans, policies and programs. Provides legislative research and analysis for various House Senate offices on matters pertaining to the Air National Guard, Air Force and the Air Force Reserve. Interacts directly with Members of United States Congress. Prepares strategy and recommends courses of action concerning defense appropriations issues to Director of the ANG and Chief of Staff of the USAF. Requires daily contact with Congressional staff in order to educate and inform them on the details of Air National Guard and Air Force budget and legislative issues. Facilitates and travels with elected Members of Congress and their staff as they visit military operations around the globe. Maintains information flow from Congress to leadership in the Air National Guard and Air Force.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

Applications will be reviewed for qualification/disqualification only starting at 72 hours prior to closeout date. For example; an MVA closing out on the 10th of the month would be reviewed for qualified or disqualified only starting on the 7th of the month.

Application for this MVA signifies agreement to the following statement, "I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, all of the information in and attached to this application is true, correct, complete and made in good faith. I understand that false or fraudulent information on or attached to this application may be grounds for rejection or for release from statutory tour after I begin work, and may be punishable by fine or imprisonment.
