Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-4 years Statutory Tour at NGB/A5 (Arlington, VA).. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) 11XX, 12XX, 62E3X. Must possess or be able to obtain a Top Secret SCI security clearance. Lieutenant Colonel applicants must have completed SDE. Lieutenant Colonel applicants must submit copies of ALL OPRs, Training Reports and Mandatory Letters of Evaluation - OPRs are required to ensure the member's record, if selected, would be competitive for promotion to Colonel. Colonel applicants only need to submit their last five OPRs. Lieutenant Colonel applicants must have a date of rank prior to 31 Dec 09 to be eligible for this vacancy and a Mandatory Separation Date (MSD) of 1 Oct 2016 or after which allows for 3 years TIG as a Col. Duties and Responsibilities: Responsible for modernization and integration of combat and mobility forces programs in the ANG. Responsibilities include requirements definition, acquisition program management, financial management, testing, and harmonizing initiatives between weapons system modernization and Homeland Defense requirements while producing various required reports and documentation for Air Force, Office of Secretary Defense, and Congressional directives. Manages the National Guard Reserve Equipment Appropriation (NGREA) across all ANG Major Weapon Systems and Domestic Operations equipment. This position represents the Director NGB/A5, as Chief of Requirements, at HQ USAF, COCOMs, MAJCOMs, SPOs and field units to integrate, document, validate, fund, procure, and bed down MWS modifications to enable completion of Air Force State missions in the ANG. This position requires extensive knowledge of aircraft systems, acquisition, capability requirements, tactics, command and control, aircraft modification procedures, and general maintenance and logistics support practices. Individual works the full range of the DoD Planning, Joint Capabilities Integration and Development Systems (JCIDS); Defense Acquisition System (DAS), Planning, Programming, Budgeting and Execution (PPBE) process from OSD, Joint Staff, Air Staff, MAJCOM, NAF, States and unit levels. Supervises personnel who are the primary point of contact for requirements and acquisition for each of the Major Weapons Systems (MWSs) in the ANG. Serves as high level point of contact for the System Program Offices (SPOs) and MAJCOMs to acquire and field capabilities. Close coordination, representing NGB leadership, with the States, Territories and Congress will be required to ensure the needs of the ANG units are met while simultaneously addressing the needs of the Combatant Commanders and Governors. The high visibility of these responsibilities requires an individual with highly polished professional skills. The individual must be thoroughly familiar with

MAJCOM capability requirements development process, DAS, JCIDS, PPBE, Congressional funding including NGREA, operational testing, and weapons systems employment across all ANG mission areas. In addition, the individual should be familiar with operations scheduling, training procedures, deployed operations, AEF cycle, and current AF CONOPS governing weapons systems. Should have a working knowledge of DoD, JCS, USAF, MAJCOM, and NGB regulations and publications applicable to operations and thorough knowledge of the functions and organizational structure of the USAF, MAJCOM, NAFs, TAGs, and ANG units.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Applications will be reviewed for qualification/disqualification only starting at 72 hours prior to closeout date. For example; an MVA closing out on the 10th of the month would be reviewed for qualified or disqualified only starting on the 7th of the month.
