Duties and Responsibilities: Coordinates with a multitude of Department of Defense (DoD) and civilian agencies to develop documentation, planning, and support capabilities to support the NORAD-USNORTHCOM (N-NC) Air Sovereignty, Homeland Security, Homeland Defense, Security Cooperation, CBRN, Civil Support and Special missions. Coordinates planning activities to support N-NC standing OPODS, Fragmentary Orders (FRAGOS) and 3000 series CONPLANS. Conducts planning activities to author and update C-NAF standing OPODS, CONPLAN supplements and EXORDS. AFNORTH Crisis Action Team Director and Chief, Future Operations Cell during N-NC contingencies and exercises. Develops Courses of Action (COAs) for the Commander. Should have supervisory skills for Officer, Enlisted, Government Service and Contract personnel. Supervises C-NAF Office of Functional Manager Oversight. Oversees development of Time Phased Force Deployment Data (TPFDD) and Global Force Management coordination with Combatant Commands, Force Providers and Joint Staff. Position is responsible for A3X coordination of 1 AF, N-NC, ACC and ANG staff functions. Prepares staff correspondence, briefings and complex technical reports for use by 1AF and Higher Headquarters (HHQ) staffs to include Combatant Commanders, MAJCOM, the Joint/Air Staff and DoD. Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-2503, Paragraph 3.8.

Members in a Special Duty Career Field (SDI)/Reporting Identifiers (RI) must submit a conditional release letter from your Functional Area Manager (FAM) stating you have fulfilled all obligations and will be released if selected for the position you are applying for. If selected for an MVA outside of the SDI (8XXX) or RDI (9XXX) you must have a fully qualified AFSC prior to accession onto Stat Tour AFSC(1XXX-7XXX)

Applications will be reviewed for qualification/disqualification only starting at 72 hours prior to closeout date. For example; an MVA closing out on the 10th of the month would be reviewed for qualified or disqualified only starting on the 7th of the month.
