Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-4 years Statutory Tour at **ACC/A2 (Joint Base Langley-Eustis)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **14N3/4**. **Must have or be able to obtain Top Secret clearance.** Duties and Responsibilities: Candidates should be familiar with USAF, MAJCOM and ANG plans, policies, procedures, readiness, manpower, personnel, and training requirements and should have a working knowledge of USAF, ACC, and NGB regulations and publications applicable to the Air National Guard. A working knowledge of the functions and organizational structure of the USAF, MAJCOMs, NAFs, TAGs, and ANG units is highly desired. Should be knowledgeable on all ANG weapon systems and intelligence architecture gained by ACC, and be able to address issues on these systems. Candidates should be familiar with the AF Corporate POM process and COMACC's role as Core Function Lead Integrator for Global Integrated Intelligence Surveillance and Reconnaissance (GIISR). Principle duties include participation in the development, review, and administering of policies, roadmaps, and programs effecting the mission, size, location, organization, distribution, mobilization, equipping and utilization of ACC-gained ANG resources. Responsible for advising ACC/A2 and staff on policies, readiness, and other issues affecting ACC gained ANG units. Implements policy and guidance established by the Director, Air National Guard (NGB/CF) and ACC/CG IAW ANGI 36-6. Desired candidate should be a skillful writer, briefer and negotiator capable of articulating complex issues, winning support for innovative ideas, and negotiating and implementing agreements. Ensures ANG inclusion in ACC programming, flight plan development, force modernization and force structure changes. Works directly with HQ USAF, and NGB/A2 directorates to ensure compatibility between ACC and wider CAF priorities.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

Applications will be reviewed for qualification/disqualification only starting at 72 hours prior to closeout date. For example; an MVA closing out on the 10th of the month would be reviewed for qualified or disqualified only starting on the 7th of the month.

Application for this MVA signifies agreement to the following statement, “I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, all of the information in and attached to this application is true, correct, complete and made in good faith. I understand that false or fraudulent information on or attached to this application may be grounds for rejection or for release from statutory tour after I begin work, and may be punishable by fine or imprisonment.
