1. Requirements

Must hold Rank/Grade requirement by this announcement closeout date.

Must have or be able to obtain a TS/SCI (Top Secret/Sensitive Compartmented Information) Security Clearance.

2. Position Description

This position requires interaction with general officers, directors, intermediate level ACC and AFRC staff members, as well as ANG senior leadership at the National Guard Bureau (NGB), 54 State/Territory Headquarters, and at wing/group level. Should have knowledge in organizational structures of ANG units as well as Active Duty, Gaining Major Air Commands and Air Logistics Centers. Should have headquarters experience; in-depth knowledge and understanding of ANG and Air Force directives, policies and procedures; in-depth knowledge of ANG force structure. The incumbent works full time in ACC/A4V15 and A4V16 for the ACC/A4G, while representing NGB/CF, ACC/A4G and ACC/CG. Extended duty hours and TDY through weekends are moderate requirements. Ensures major modifications to aircraft are incorporated in a timely manner. Develops strategies to ensure long-range logistics support for all CAF fighter aircraft and associated support equipment. Principle duties include participation in the development, review and administering of policies, Roadmaps, and programs effecting the mission, size, location, organization, distribution, mobilization, equipping and utilization of ACC-gained ANG resources. Responsible for advising ACC/A4V, A8A, and staff on policies, readiness, and other issues affecting ACC gained ANG units..

3. Application Reminders

It is your responsibility to ensure your vMPF Personnel RIP is in order prior to application submittal. This includes but not limited to, verifying Duty History, AFSC, Service Dates and ensuring overdue TDY codes are cleared.

4. About Statutory Tours

This is a fully funded Permanent Change of Station (PCS). Visit DFAS website for most current Basic Allowance Housing (BAH) & Basic Allowance Substance (BAS) rates for the duty location listed on this announcement.

All Members assigned to the Statutory Tour program will remain affiliated their State/Territory while serving on Statutory Tour.

All field members to include AGR, Technicians & Drill Status Guardsmen must obtain State TAG approval with application submittal. Members currently assigned to the Statutory Tour program must obtain current Director approval.

Statutory Tour service time does not count toward Reduced Eligibility Age for Reserve Retirement Pay.

Statutory Tour members may be eligible for the Post 9/11 GI Bill if they serve on active duty Title 10 and/or Title 32 502(f) AGR for 90 days or more, after 11 September 2001. Their eligibility percentage starts at 40% for 90 days to 5 months. It increases 10% every 6 months, maxing out at 100%.
