1. Requirements

Must hold Rank/Grade requirement by this announcement closeout date.

Must have or be able to obtain a TS/SCI (Top Secret/Sensitive Compartmented Information) Security Clearance.

Must possess a terminal degree (i.e., PhD, JD, equivalent) in a field relevant to strategic studies to teach at SAASS.

2. Position Description

Focal point for the Air National Guard at SAASS; recruits Air National Guard students from the eligible pool of IDE students and graduates; helps to place Guard graduates in strategically significant follow on tours; coordinates closely with ANG advisor to Air University and the ANG advisor to the Spaatz Center; designs courses and write syllabi; teaches courses; advises on master's theses; serves on comprehensive oral exam panels; conducts Air Staff-directed and other scholarly research; contributes to policy debates; writes training reports; mentors students; hosts distinguished guests; serves as NGB focal point for contacting and assembling ANG SAASS graduates to assist with NGB special projects; and carries out standard unit additional duties.

Advises the Commandant on issues involving the Air National Guard and Air Force Reserve; educates the Air Force's future strategists while providing a Citizen-Airman perspective.

Integrates the Air National Guard (ANG) mission, interests and equities into the Air Force's premier school for strategists. Assists the SAASS program with achieving a broad Total Force educational mission, by including an Air National Guard officer.

A faculty position at a school where the students are O-4s and O-5s and all faculty members are terminally degreed O-5s, O-6s, or the civilian equivalents. Incumbent must meet the qualifications to serve as an associate professor. SAASS is the highest visibility and most selective education program in the Air Force.

Should have experience gained from serving in ANG unit(s) in the field, the National Guard Bureau (NGB), or both.

SAASS's mission is to educate strategists for the Air Force and the nation. Between 44 and 46 students graduate annually from this intensive 50-week program and earn a Masters of Philosophy in Military Strategy.

3. Application Reminders

Pen/ink changes to any source document, i.e. Report on Individual Personnel (RIP), Evaluations could result in disapproval.

It is your responsibility to ensure your vMPF Personnel RIP is in order prior to application submittal. This includes but not limited to, verifying Duty History, AFSC, Service Dates and ensuring overdue TDY codes are cleared.

4. About Statutory Tours

This is a fully funded Permanent Change of Station (PCS). Visit DFAS website for most current Basic Allowance Housing (BAH) & Basic Allowance Substance (BAS) rates for the duty location listed on this announcement.

All Members assigned to the Statutory Tour program will remain affiliated their State/Territory while serving on Statutory Tour.

All field members to include AGR, Technicians & Drill Status Guardsmen must obtain State TAG approval with application submittal. Members currently assigned to the Statutory Tour program must obtain current Director approval.

Statutory Tour service time does not count toward Reduced Eligibility Age for Reserve Retirement Pay.

Statutory Tour members may be eligible for the Post 9/11 GI Bill if they serve on active duty Title 10 and/or Title 32 502(f) AGR for 90 days or more, after 11 September 2001. Their eligibility percentage starts at 40% for 90 days to 5 months. It increases 10% every 6 months, maxing out at 100%.
