1. Requirements

Must hold Rank/Grade requirement by this announcement closeout date.

Must have or be able to obtain a TS/SCI (Top Secret/Sensitive Compartmented Information) Security Clearance.

2. Position Description

Highly desired: applicant have SDE completed. Position should have military training and expertise in developing Cyberspace and Space force structure and funding options supporting the full spectrum of operational requirements for AF and ANG. As the Chief, ANG Cyberspace and Space Programming Branch, responsible to prepare USAF Program Objective Memorandum, financial plan reviews and Budget Estimate Submission inputs. Works directly with Cyberspace and Space operations Program Element Monitors (PEM) and Functional Area Monitors (FAM) to guide and direct Planning, Programming, Budgeting, and Execution (PPBE) efforts. Develops, presents, and coordinates cyberspace and space PPBE issues for the ANG. Cyberspace includes Cyber Warfare, Combat Communications, Engineering and Installation, and Information Technology Services Management. Coordinates with and represents ANG Cyberspace and Space resource equities with numerous commands including United States Strategic Command (USSTRATCOM), United States Northern Command (USNORTHCOM), United States Cyber Command (USCYBERCOM), Air Force Space Command (AFSPC), Air Combat Command (ACC), 24th and 14th Air Forces. Responsible for all ANG Cyberspace and Space programming guidance, analysis, and resource recommendations to Chief, Nuclear, Space and Information Operations; Director, Air, Space and Information Directorate; and Director, ANG, through the Space and Cyber Superiority Panel. Coordinates with HQ USAF, MAJCOM, JFHQ-States and ANG field units to determine program requirements. Monitors execution of authorized funding. Ensures ANG CW and IO capabilities are programmed and equipped to support Air Force, and joint requirements to the maximum extent possible. Highly desired qualifications include: Extensive background in, knowledge of and experience with cyberspace and/or space is highly desired. Strong leadership, management and effective communication skills are highly desired. Familiarity and or experience with the PPBE system (as PEM or acquisition program manager) highly desired. Should have the ability to analyze logically and objectively, apply sound judgment in assessing possible solutions, and adjust to changing priorities; and be able to implement these traits in daily operations. Service, joint and/or interagency planning experience highly desired. Should have a working knowledge of the functions and organization structure of the NGB, USAF, MAJCOMs, NAFs, TAGs, and ANG.

3. Application Reminders

Pen/ink changes to any source document, i.e. Report on Individual Personnel (RIP), Evaluations could result in disapproval.

It is your responsibility to ensure your vMPF Personnel RIP is in order prior to application submittal. This includes but not limited to, verifying Duty History, AFSC, Service Dates and ensuring overdue TDY codes are cleared.

4. About Statutory Tours

This is a fully funded Permanent Change of Station (PCS). Visit DFAS website for most current Basic Allowance Housing (BAH) & Basic Allowance Substance (BAS) rates for the duty location listed on this announcement.

All Members assigned to the Statutory Tour program will remain affiliated their State/Territory while serving on Statutory Tour.

All field members to include AGR, Technicians & Drill Status Guardsmen must obtain State TAG approval with application submittal. Members currently assigned to the Statutory Tour program must obtain current Director approval.

Statutory Tour service time does not count toward Reduced Eligibility Age for Reserve Retirement Pay.

Statutory Tour members may be eligible for the Post 9/11 GI Bill if they serve on active duty Title 10 and/or Title 32 502(f) AGR for 90 days or more, after 11 September 2001. Their eligibility percentage starts at 40% for 90 days to 5 months. It increases 10% every 6 months, maxing out at 100%.
