POSITION TITLE: Aircraft Loadmaster (Instructor) (GS-2185-09; PD D0323000)(4 Positions)

MILITARY GRADE REQUIREMENTS: Enlisted Not to Exceed SSgt/E-5

LOCATION: 189th Airlift Wing (AW), Little Rock Air Force Base (LRAFB), AR

NOMINATING OFFICIAL: CMSgt Sean Harre, Aircraft Loadmaster (Instructor)

Individual selected will be ordered to full time duty (state) in Active Guard/Reserve status under Title 32 USC 502(f). Benefits will be commensurate with grade/rank and years of service.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: (1) All Onboard members of the Arkansas Air National Guard. (2) All others who are members of the Arkansas Air National Guard or those eligible to become members.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: Minimum grade of SrA/E-5, Maximum grade of SSgt/E-5. Must possess AFSC K1A2X1 (requires a minimum General Aptitude score of 57) and a minimum PULHES of 111121. Applicant must meet Body Composition and Physical Fitness Standards as stated in Air Force Instruction (AFI) 36-2905. Prior to induction into AGR Program selectee must meet all required medical standards in AFI 48-123. **Note:** Individuals who exceed the maximum grade of this position (see Military Grade Requirement above) may apply; however, they will be required to accept an administrative reduction in grade prior to being placed into this position. **Must possess or be able to obtain a Secret security clearance.**

PLACEMENT FACTORS: Selectee will be subject to uncommon tours of duty, rotational shift assignments and overtime duty. May be required to fly in military or commercial aircraft for Temporary Duty (TDY) purposes. Prior to entry on tour, selectee will meet the physical qualifications outlined in Chapter 7, AFI 48-123. Reserve Component Physical Health Assessment must medically qualify selectee within 12 months prior to entry on Military Duty. Selectee will participate in unit of assignment during Unit Training Assemblies (UTAs) and Annual Training periods including deployments, special projects and exercises. Upon assignment, must be a member of the 189th AW, and assigned to a compatible military position in AFSC K1A2X1. **If applicant selected does not possess the AFSC, they must sign an agreement to retrain IAW ANGI 36-101, Chapter 5.**

SUMMARY OF DUTIES: The incumbent conducts training for worldwide capability to include initial qualification, continuation training and/or upgrade and specialized training.

Training includes actual on the job practice and formal classroom instruction. Analyzes and interprets guidance, writes or modifies general guidelines from a broad scope of principles, concepts, technology and methodology of the loadmaster career field and forms practical lesson plans for flying training instruction. Keeps records on training. Analyzes and evaluates training accomplishments to determine the effectiveness of training. Reviews maintenance directives, bulletins and flight manuals that relate to loadmasters to keep abreast of changes, to determine the adequacy of procedures and techniques for unit's mission and recommends changes as necessary. Performs other duties as assigned.
