1. Requirements

Must hold Rank/Grade and AFSC requirement by this announcement closeout date.

Must have or be able to obtain a Top Secret Security Clearance

(Note: All security clearances must be reflected on VMPF RIP. Date of Investigation must be within the past 10 years for Secret and with the last 5 years for Top Secret. If your security clearance is expired on your VMPF, please submit an MFR from your security manager indicating that the reinvestigation has been initiated. DO NOT Submit a JPAS print out.)

Lt Col Applicants must have a DOR no later than 1 Jun 2012 and must submit ALL OPRs with no gaps in time (includes AF Form 77s, AF Form 475s, & AF Form 707s, if applicable).

Col applicants must submit last 5 OPRs with no gaps in time (includes AF Form 77s, AF Form 475s, & AF Form 707s, if applicable).

LtCol Applicants must have completed SDE as indicated on vMPF RIP.

2. Position Description

API 8: Serves as Staff Integrator and program manager on any/all strategic and tactical operational issues related to ANG/Air National Guard Readiness Center (ANGRC) affairs and the TACC. Monitors all aspects of operational readiness, training and utilization of AMC-gained ANG forces. Provides liaison assistance on operational matters between AMC and the National Guard Bureau (NGB) in the discharge of gaining command responsibilities. Supplies ANG operational advisory assistance to functional staff agencies throughout the directorate and the AMC staff.

-ANG Tanker Airlift Control Center advisor/focal point for planning and coordinating operational activities as they pertain to AMC-gained ANG units. Provides technical guidance concerning ANG operational procedures, requirements and limitations. Monitors and keeps 618 TACC Commander apprised of operational readiness of AMC-ANG gained units and initiates assistance to eliminate deficiencies. Assists in development and presentation of briefings concerning ANG readiness and conversions of AMC gained ANG resources.

-Maintains constant involvement with all ANG units to provide comprehensive data to the 618 TACC staff on the impact of ANG actions on utilizing ANG assets.

-Interfaces directly with AMC staff, including senior officers, AMC commanders and at all levels within ANG/ANGRC on matters regarding the use of ANG forces. Facilitates dialogue between ANG and AMC functional managers on tasking's and requirements.

-Participates in ANG activities and visits Guard units to remain current on tasking's and requirements. Sources ANG forces to support active Air Force programs and requirements.

-Monitors the collection, verification and analysis of statistical data pertaining to AMC tanker/airlift forces by the AMC staff. Provides the ANG with this data and the interpretation given to it by AMC and possible impact on ANG activities.

- Maintains liaison between HQ AMC, NGB, USAF, NAF and other concerned agencies in regard to the ANG units to be gained upon mobilization.
- Provides recommendations to exercise section for deployment and employment of strategic/tactical airlift units in OCONUS operations.
- Aids in the approval and direction of ANG airlift (when required and authorized in support of special missions (US Army Special Forces, etc.)
- In the absence of the senior ANG officer to the TACC Commander, assumes all duties and responsibilities for that office.

3. Application Reminders

Pen/ink changes to any source document, i.e. Report on Individual Personnel (RIP), Evaluations could result in disapproval.

It is your responsibility to ensure your vMPF Personnel RIP is in order prior to application submittal. This includes but not limited to, verifying Duty History, AFSC, Service Dates and ensuring overdue TDY codes are cleared.

4. About Statutory Tours

This is a fully funded Permanent Change of Station (PCS). Visit DFAS website for most current Basic Allowance Housing (BAH) & Basic Allowance Substance (BAS) rates for the duty location listed on this announcement.

All Members assigned to the Statutory Tour program will remain affiliated their State/Territory while serving on Statutory Tour.

All field members to include AGR, Technicians & Drill Status Guardsmen must obtain State TAG approval with application submittal. Members currently assigned to the Statutory Tour program must obtain current Director approval.

Statutory Tour service time does not count toward Reduced Eligibility Age for Reserve Retirement Pay.

Statutory Tour members may be eligible for the Post 9/11 GI Bill if they serve on active duty Title 10 and/or Title 32 502(f) AGR for 90 days or more, after 11 September 2001. Their eligibility percentage starts at 40% for 90 days to 5 months. It increases 10% every 6 months, maxing out at 100%.

Application packages will be reviewed to ensure qualifications are met. Packages are reviewed within 4 duty days of receipt. You may visit <https://airguard.ang.af.mil/om/vacancy/> for a status update. Do not call for a status update within the four (4) duty day period.
