## **1. Requirements**

Must hold Rank/Grade and AFSC requirement by this announcement closeout date.

Must have a Secret Security Clearance

*(Note: All security clearances must be reflected on VMPF RIP. Date of Investigation must be within the past 10 years for Secret and with the last 5 years for Top Secret. If your security clearance is expired on your VMPF, please submit an MFR from your security manager indicating that the reinvestigation has been initiated. DO NOT Submit a JPAS print out.)*

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## **2. Position Description**

A. Perform engineering and planning studies and develops installation plans.

- Plans and prepares cost estimates and economic analyses, collects and analyzes engineering and facility data.
- Presents findings and prepares reports and prepares facility replacement plans.
- Act as liaison for Asset Management Optimization between ANGRC staff, field agencies, Installation Development Plans (IDP), Real Property and Asset Management.

B. Works with MAJCOM Real Property Manager to interpret, record, and evaluate Installation Real Property Records, comparing with ANGRC standards.

- Maintain folders and files pertaining to real property records and conduct staff assistance visits as requested.
- Coordinates with installation Base Engineer staffs on the use and update of installation real property records.
- Evaluates contract performance schedules and submittals/report preparations pertaining to contracted real property functions.
- Identifies issues and problem affecting ANG real property and advises ANGRC staff of any impact.
- Participates in staff action packages or other joint action reviews affecting Real Property.
- Assembles various reports required to support the requirements of other AF/OSD/Government Agencies.

C. Directs Asset Management Optimization functions.

- Focuses on tools and techniques used in the optimization of installation natural and built infrastructure.
- Focuses on how asset management is implemented through Activity Management and Comprehensive Asset Management planning.
- Serve as focal point for development, implementation and sustainment of ANG's Asset Management tools and will provide recommendations for resourcing.
- Coordinates training on Sustainment Manager Suite which includes BUILDER, PAVER, ROOFER, and RAILER
- Develops implementation policy regarding execution and sustainment of SMS

D. Directs or perform contract management functions.

- Interprets Statement of Work regarding Asset Management Optimization data collection for vertical and linear assets.
  - Participate in Asset Management Integration Working Group.
  - Documents architect-engineer contract activities and makes appropriate data base entries.
  - Evaluates software submittals and makes comparisons with ANGRC standards.
  - Review contract modification and coordinates approval and funding activities.
  - Coordinates with installation base engineer staffs on use and update of Asset Management Optimization tools.
  - Evaluates contract performance schedules and submittals/reports preparation.
  - Identifies issues and problems and advises ANGRC staff of potential impact using S-File and BUILDER databases.
  - Participates in making recommendations on installation development alternatives and IPL policy.
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E. Provides guidance and oversees development of policy, ETLs, Point papers, etc.

F. Responsible for and provides oversight of the review of all regulations, manuals, and ETLs that impact ANG real property.

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### **3. Application Reminders**

If you are currently assigned to a Special Duty Identifier (SDI) as outlined in the Air Force Enlisted Classification Directory (AFECD) it is your responsibility to submit an approved conditional release memorandum with your application from your Functional Area Manager (FAM) stating you have fulfilled all obligations and will be released if selected for the position you are applying for. Failure to submit conditional release before listed closeout will result in disqualification from this announcement.

Promotion Opportunity: If this Military Vacancy Announcement is a promotion opportunity and you are currently assigned to a Special Duty Identifier (SDI), you must meet the promotion requirements as outlined in ANGI 36-2502.

If you are currently assigned to a Reporting Identifiers (RI), it is your responsibility to submit an approved conditional release letter with your application from your Commander/Director.

Applicants who are in a higher grade than the grade for this advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with your application stating you are willing to be voluntarily demoted without prejudice if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-2503, Paragraph 3.8. If selected for this vacancy, voluntary demotion action must take place prior to being assessed to the Statutory Tour Program.

Pen/ink changes to any source document, i.e. Report on Individual Personnel (RIP), Evaluations could result in disapproval.

It is your responsibility to ensure your vMPF Personnel RIP is in order prior to application submittal. This includes but not limited to, verifying Duty History, AFSC, Service Dates and ensuring overdue TDY codes are cleared.

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### **4. About Statutory Tours**

This is a fully funded Permanent Change of Station (PCS). Visit DFAS website for most current Basic Allowance Housing (BAH) & Basic Allowance Substance (BAS) rates for the duty location listed on this announcement.

All Members assigned to the Statutory Tour program will remain affiliated their State/Territory while serving on Statutory Tour.

All field members to include AGR, Technicians & Drill Status Guardsmen must obtain State TAG approval with application submittal. Members currently assigned to the Statutory Tour program must obtain current Director approval.

Statutory Tour members may be eligible for the Post 9/11 GI Bill if they serve on active duty Title 10 and/or Title 32 502(f) AGR for 90 days or more, after 11 September 2001. Their eligibility percentage starts at 40% for 90 days to 5 months. It increases 10% every 6 months, maxing out at 100%.

Statutory Tour service time does not count toward Reduced Eligibility Age for Reserve Retirement Pay.

Application packages will be reviewed to ensure qualifications are met. Packages are reviewed within 4 duty days of receipt. You may visit <https://airguard.ang.af.mil/om/vacancy/> for a status update. Do not call for a status update within the four (4) duty day period.
