1. Requirements

Must hold Rank/Grade and AFSC requirement by this announcement closeout date.

Must have or be able to obtain a TS/SCI (Top Secret/Sensitive Compartmented Information) Security Clearance (*Note: All security clearances must be reflected on VMPF RIP. Date of Investigation must be within the past 10 years for Secret and with the last 5 years for Top Secret. If your security clearance is expired on your VMPF, please submit an MFR from your security manager indicating that the reinvestigation has been initiated. DO NOT Submit a JPAS print out.*)

2. Position Description

API: 8 (Rated position that requires flying)

Serves as the PR/SOF Functional Area Manager. The position of PR/SOF Aviation FAM is the ANG FAM for the following weapons systems: HC-130H/N/P, HC-130J, EC-130J, MC-130J, HH-60G, C-32, Gatekeeper and Commando Solo programs. Officer will be appointed and held responsible for the management and planning of all aviation UTCs associated with the weapon systems identified above. This includes ensuring all UTCs have the appropriate personnel and equipment to support wartime requirements/contingencies tasking. Within the planning process, the incumbent is responsible for the following planning areas to include: functional planning guidance, asset management, tracking unit tasking, OPLAN analysis, execution responsibilities, and other duties as assigned. Focal point for all issues pertaining to operational planning, deployment execution, and readiness reporting supporting Air National Guard current operation and execution plans. Responsible to partnership with the National Guard, Air Staff, States, and Directorate Functional Area Managers to integrate and incorporate all combat aviation and support units into the wartime operational planning and crisis deployments execution at all levels (Combat Commands, OSD, JCS, USAF, MAJCOM).

Officer has authority concerning the availability of SOF and PR aviation UTCs for potential real world contingencies. Officer will coordinate with the pilot units and the gaining MAJCOM FAMs on aviation UTCs availability. This includes its documentation within the WMP System. Ensures UTC availability constitutes coupling taskings with units that are manned, trained, and equipped to provide the tasked capability. Maintains close communication and coordination with the ANG SOF and Rescue Program Element Monitors (PEMs) along with the ANG Exercise/Deployments schedulers. Officer will attend the monthly SOF and Personnel Recovery Integrated Process Team (IPT) and Weapon System Councils and Operations Group Councils supporting the weapon system.

3. Application Reminders

Pen/ink changes to any source document, i.e. Report on Individual Personnel (RIP), Evaluations could result in disapproval.

It is your responsibility to ensure your vMPF Personnel RIP is in order prior to application submittal. This includes but not limited to, verifying Duty History, AFSC, Service Dates and ensuring overdue TDY codes are cleared.

4. About Statutory Tours

This is a fully funded Permanent Change of Station (PCS). Visit DFAS website for most current Basic Allowance Housing (BAH) & Basic Allowance Substance (BAS) rates for the duty location listed on this announcement.

All Members assigned to the Statutory Tour program will remain affiliated their State/Territory while serving on Statutory Tour.

All field members to include AGR, Technicians & Drill Status Guardsmen must obtain State TAG approval with application submittal. Members currently assigned to the Statutory Tour program must obtain current Director approval.

Statutory Tour service time does not count toward Reduced Eligibility Age for Reserve Retirement Pay.

Statutory Tour members may be eligible for the Post 9/11 GI Bill if they serve on active duty Title 10 and/or Title 32 502(f) AGR for 90 days or more, after 11 September 2001. Their eligibility percentage starts at 40% for 90 days to 5 months. It increases 10% every 6 months, maxing out at 100%.

Application packages will be reviewed to ensure qualifications are met. Packages are reviewed within 4 duty days of receipt. You may visit <https://airguard.ang.af.mil/om/vacancy/> for a status update. Do not call for a status update within the four (4) duty day period.
