Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-3 year Statutory Tour at **NGB-GO (Arlington, VA)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **ANY;3S0X1**. **If the member does not already possess the 3S0X1 AFSC, then the individual must: 1. Provide a statement of understanding with the application stating they will retrain into 3S0X1 within one year. 2. Have an admin score of 41. 3. Provide a current AF Form 422 with a PULHES score of 3, 3, 3, 2, 3, 3 or better.**

Duties and Responsibilities: Manages all Air National Guard general officer assignments, promotions, retirements, separations, MSD & time in grade waivers, and grade determination boards within established laws, regulations, and policies. Coordinates with Secretary of Air Force for promotion and special board actions and processes all post board actions through Office of Secretary of Defense to the White House within the most efficient manner possible.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-25-03, Paragraph 3.4.3.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

Application for this MVA signifies agreement to the following statement, in accordance with (IAW) Title 18 USC 1001: "I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, all of the information on an

attached to this application is true, correct, complete and made in good faith.
