Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-4 year Statutory Tour at **NGB/A3 (Joint Base Andrews, MD)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **1B471, 3D072, 3D073, 3D074**. **Must have or be able to obtain Top Secret SCI**. Duties and Responsibilities: Position assists with cyber warfare (CW) unit functional area management (FAM) duties; assists in providing program support, guidance and oversight to ANG CW units. The incumbent acts as a point of contact between ANG field units, and numerous outside agencies in matters concerning CW training, operations, exercises, deployments, inspections, manpower, conferences and awards programs. Provides FAM and administrative support for ANG CW field units. Advises and assists the CW and information operation (IO) FAMs and supported units on unit mission development and assignment, unit type code (UTC) development and refinement, unit manning, and deployments. Provides technical and administrative coordination of CW units' systems development and acquisition. Coordinates FAM requirements with other NGB organizations and Air Force Space Command (AFSPC) functional representatives. Assists branch leadership in subject matter expert review of key Service/Joint CW publications. Functions as the branch's liaison with key enlisted NGB career field managers (e.g., 3Dxxx, 1B4x1, 1Nxxx) on behalf of CW/IO units. Experience in Service, Joint and/or interagency cyberspace operations and/or cyber warfare (CW) is required. Experience managing or utilizing designed operational capability (DOC) statements, unit type codes (UTC), unit manning documents (UMD) and/or deployment processes is desired. Previous staff experience (especially within NGB, USCYBERCOM, AFSPC or AFCYBER-24AF) or experience in an ANG CW unit is desired.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-25-03, Paragraph 3.4.3.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.
