MUST HAVE OR BE ABLE TO OBTAIN A TOP SECRET CLEARANCE.** Duties and Responsibilities: **"CCAF is highly recommended" Two years BCS-F System Administration/Maintenance experience highly desired.** Provides maintenance and infrastructure support for all command and control, communications, computer, and intelligence (C4I) systems and related infrastructure. Incumbent liaisons between the unit and various test agencies on all connectivity issues. Installs, maintains, and repairs a variety of C4I systems such as the BCS-F, GCCS, JRE and ADSI. Provides operating system software, hardware, and network expertise, engineering and support system configuration management for supported test programs. Provides technical advice on many aspects of C4I systems testing, to include communications planning, connectivity, architecture, and security. Develops and writes methods and procedures used in the configuration, operation, administration, and maintenance of systems under test/development. Analyzes plan for the employment and utilization of network/circuit analysis, performance monitoring, radar performance analysis, and protocol analyzer equipment on large air defense and theater air operations command and control networks. Manages security and IP programs. Controls, issues, and accounts for communications security material and equipment. Inspects form compliance with control, accountability, use, handling, and technical specification concerning security elements. Reports security incidents and formulates and applies corrective security procedures. Provides guidance for communications, computers, information, and emission security matters. Manages, directs, and educates users on communications, computer, information, and IP security. Performs data reduction when requested. Produces requested output to customer in magnetic media format and/or hard copy. Performs entry access combination lock changes to secure areas. Attends meetings as necessary to provide briefings, information, and/or technical support. Performs other duties as assigned.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-2503, Paragraph 3.8.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

REGAF Officers IAW AFI 36-2005 Table 2.2 item 27 are not authorized to apply if they have over 18 years TAFMS.
