Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **52R3/4**. **Colonel applicants must submit the last five OPRs/Training Reports/Mandatory Letters of Evaluation. Lieutenant Colonel applicants must submit ALL OPRs/Training Reports/Mandatory Letters of Evaluation – These documents are required to ensure the member's record, if selected, would be competitive for promotion to Colonel. Lieutenant Colonel applicants must have a date of rank prior to 30 Jun 2010. MSD (Mandatory Separation Date) must be on or after 1 Apr 2017. Duties and Responsibilities:** Serves as Director of ANG Chaplain Service, advisor to the Director, Air National Guard and Headquarters United States Air Force Chief of Chaplains on all matters that pertain to religious life, morale, and related activities of the Air National Guard. Monitors recruitment, appointments, and assignments of over 500 chaplains and chaplain assistants. Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation. Officers applying for this statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Masters of Divinity or equivalent degree prior to applying.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.
