Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-4 years Statutory Tour at **1AF/A4 (Tyndall AFB, FL)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC). **21R3/4. API 0**. Duties and Responsibilities: Incumbent will contribute full spectrum 21R3/4 duties and responsibilities as defined in paragraph 1.2 of the AFSC 21RX Logistics Readiness Officer Career Field Education and Training Plan (CFETP) dated 1 Nov 2009. Serves as a Component Numbered Air Force (C-NAF) Logistics Readiness Action Officer with responsibility as the Air Force service component to US Northern Command (USNORTHCOM) and to North American Aerospace Defense Command's (NORAD) Continental U.S. Air Defense Region (CONR). Also, to analyze logistic contingency readiness programs and plans, providing advice and assistance to higher-level management during short/long term planning for Homeland Defense (HLD) and Defense Support to Civil Authorities (DSCA) purposes. Coordinates logistics requirements and capabilities for HLD and DSCA at various command levels to include HQ USAF, USNORTHCOM, Major Commands, National Guard Bureau (NGB), and USAF installations in the NORTHCOM Area of Responsibility (AOR). Provides logistics expertise, recommendations, oversight, monitoring and corrective action affecting Air Force Forces (AFFOR) mission capabilities. Ensures coordinated logistics requirements during deployment, employment and redeployment. Reviews and analyzes logistical impacts of stated DOD requirements on Base Support Installations (BSI) and/or stated Lead Federal Agency requirements on Installation Support Bases (ISB). Represents 1AF (AFNORTH) A4 as Logistics Readiness subject matter expert at all levels of command including Air Staff, NORAD/NORTHCOM, MAJCOMS, NGB, 1 AF (AFNORTH/CONR) Staff and USAF installations. Participates in Joint Planning Groups to develop Courses of Action (COAs) for the COMAFFOR/JFACC. Participates in special projects and initiatives to develop various systems and/or procedures. Identifies and initiates milestones and goals when developing Concepts of Logistical support. Evaluates reports by analyzing facts, performs appropriate research and prepares detailed responses. Determines appropriate recommendations for unresolved problems and performs follow up. Researches and determines or recommends appropriate actions or interpretation of issues that impact directorate, 1 AF (AFNORTH/CONR) staff, command, or agency. Develops and delivers briefings and presentations to directorate and 1 AF (AFNORTH/CONR) Staff leadership. Manages, administers and conducts logistics planning. Develops, coordinates, and implements HLD and DSCA plans, policies and procedures for deployment and reception to include; weapons systems, personnel, ammunition, equipment, supplies, fuel and vehicles. Reviews and makes recommendations to improve and update joint logistics doctrine and publications as required. Conducts and coordinates

reviews of NORAD/NORTHCOM plans and logistics annexes. Develops and coordinates and writes logistics annexes for 1AF (AFNORTH/CONR) supplements to NORAD/NORTHCOM plans. Conducts and coordinates site survey assessments of DoD airfields/installations as well as civil airfields to identify logistical limiting factors (LIMFACS) when determining suitability for DSCA or HLD assigned missions. Manages, analyzes and administers logistics readiness, associated systems, and required reports. Coordinates, manages, and oversees training, resources, and systems to ensure the efficient and effective operation of Logistical Automated Information Systems (AIS). Evaluates all manpower, resource, procedural, and capability issues that impact mission essential UTCs. Plans and coordinates logistics UTC requirements and activities with the operations directorate as a Functional Area Manager. Provides subject matter expertise on a variety of logistics UTCs and coordinates the input and use of these UTCs into the Joint Operations Planning Execution System (JOPES) and Deliberate Crisis Action Planning Execution Segment (DCAPES) systems. Plans, updates and writes new UTC MISCAPs as required and develops new UTCs to meet 1AF (AFNORTH) mission assignments. Reviews plans and administers logistics programs, to ensure compliance with legal and regulatory requirements. Establishes reviews and revises policies, procedures, and mission objectives, as necessary to eliminate barriers to mission accomplishment. Provides supervisors and staff with direction and advice regarding policies, procedures, and guidelines. Works closely with operations directorate to ensure war plans Wartime Aircraft Activity Reports (WAAR) are analyzed to determine WRM (War Reserve Material) requirements and input into the Logistics Feasibility Assessment Capability (LOGFAC) system. Performs other duties as assigned.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelors degree prior to applying.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-2503, Paragraph 3.8.

Members in a Special Duty Career Field (SDI)/Reporting Identifiers (RI) must submit a conditional release letter from your Functional Area Manager (FAM) stating you have fulfilled all obligations and will be released if selected for the position you are applying for. If selected for an MVA outside of the SDI (8XXX) or RDI (9XXX) you must have a fully qualified AFSC prior to accession onto Stat Tour AFSC(1XXX-7XXX)

MilPDS, the Military Personnel Data System, will temporarily SHUTDOWN 4-27 March 13.

Several personnel programs including vMPF and AFFMS (AF Fitness Management System) will be stagnant and possibly inaccessible. Members MUST pull a copy of their Records Review (RIP from vMPF) and Fitness Report (from AFFMS) NLT 28 Feb 2013.

Fitness Update: If you test during the MILPDS shutdown, 4-27 Mar, provide a signed copy of your completed test results from the Fitness Testing Cell or PTL (Physical Training Leader).

AFSC Upgrade: If your AFSC is upgraded during the MILPDS shutdown, provide a copy of the completed AF Form 2096 documenting the update.

No exceptions to close-out dates will be made

Note: Email constraints limit the size of an application to 4 MB. If you do not receive an email confirmation within 24 hours of submitting a package please contact us immediately. Applications will be reviewed for qualification/disqualification only starting at 72 hours prior to closeout date. For example; an MVA closing out on the 10th of the month would be reviewed for qualified or disqualified only starting on the 7th of the month.
