### CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT DAVID BRADLEY CALLAGHAN, SR

Chief Master Sergeant David B. Callaghan Sr is the Command Chief Master Sergeant for the Air National Guard Readiness Center (ANGRC), Joint Base Andrews, Maryland. He is the principal advisor to the ANGRC Commander on all enlisted matters. His responsibilities include keeping the Commander informed of all issues affecting the health, morale, welfare, readiness, and proper utilization of enlisted personnel assigned to the ANGRC and its operating locations, who serve more than 108,000 Air National Guard Members.

Chief Callaghan Enlisted in the Air Force in June of 1993 and was assigned to F. E. Warren AFB in Cheyenne Wyoming. While on Active Duty Chief Callaghan was assigned to the 37<sup>th</sup> Rescue Flight as an Information Management Specialist, the 90<sup>th</sup> Operations Support Squadron as a Computer Systems Security Officer, and to the 90<sup>th</sup> Security Police Squadron as an Air Base Defense Team augmentee. Chief Callaghan transitioned to the Air National Guard in 1996. As a Guardsman in the District of Columbia he has served in the 231<sup>st</sup> Combat Communications Squadron, the 121<sup>st</sup> Fighter Squadron, the 113<sup>th</sup> Operations Support Squadron, and the 113<sup>th</sup> Operations Group as an Aviation Resource Management Craftsman, Flight Scheduler, Airfield Manager, Flight Services Manager, and Group Superintendent.



Chief Callaghan went on to serve as the Enlisted Advisor to the Air National Guard Director's Action Group, Office of the Director, Pentagon, where he provided enlisted perspective on all strategic communications and ANG programs to internal and external organizations, and prepared strategic messaging and engagement support for the Director, Deputy Director, Executive Director, and Command Chief of the Air National Guard. His most recent assignment was as the Command Chief for the 113<sup>th</sup> Wing, District of Columbia Air National Guard where he was the Senior Enlisted Leader of the Wing, and the principal advisor to the Commander on all matters influencing the readiness, morale, and welfare of the enlisted force of the wing.

Chief Callaghan has participated in numerous large scale training exercises including Air Warrior and Red Flag at Nellis Air Force Base, Nevada; and Cope Thunder at Eielson Air Force Base, Alaska. He has deployed overseas on five different occasions in support of Operation Northern Watch, Coronet Nighthawk, Operation Iraqi Freedom, and Operation New Dawn; and represented the enlisted men and woman of the DC National Guard during the signing of their State Partnership Program agreement in the African country of Burkina Faso. He has served as Secretary, Vice President, and President of the DCANG Chiefs' Council.
