CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT DAVID J. ROTH

CMSgt David J. Roth serves as the Senior Enlisted Leader, National Guard Bureau A5/8, Plans, Programs, and Requirements Directorate, Air National Guard Readiness Center, Joint Base Andrews, Maryland. He advises the Director on all matters influencing the morale, welfare, quality of life and professional development of the Airmen assigned. NGB/A5/8's mission is to lead, integrate, and execute strategy, planning, programming, and capability requirements efforts to ensure the ANG is ready today and stronger tomorrow.

Chief Roth entered the Air National Guard in August 1996 as an Aircraft Electrical and Environmental systems apprentice with the 128th Air Refueling Wing, Milwaukee, WI. During his 15 years in the maintenance squadron Chief Roth deployed in support of Operations Allied Force, Deliberate Freedom, OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM, Southern Watch, Joint Forge, and OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM. In 2008 Chief Roth was selected to serve as the AMXS First Sergeant advising the commander on all issues related to the enlisted force and exercising general supervision over assigned enlisted personnel. After completing his First Sergeant tour, Chief Roth was selected as the Aero Repair and Reclamation Shop Supervisor. In this role, he played a key part in revitalizing the Wing's Crash, Damaged, and Disabled Aircraft Recovery programs, including both equipment and training. In March 2015, he served as the Senior Enlisted Leader of the 128th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, where he provided vital leadership and management experience in organizing, equipping, training, and mobilizing the squadron to meet both home station and expeditionary mission requirements effectively. In 2019, seeking a developmental opportunity, Chief Roth was selected for a Strategic Force Planner and Programmer Active Duty for Operational Support position at the Air National Guard Readiness Center. During this time, he was responsible for preparing, validating, and distributing Air National Guard strategic force planning and programming documents, including flight plans and white papers, as approved and directed by the Director of the Air National Guard. Finally in April 2022, Chief Roth transferred to the Pennsylvania Air National Guard with his current unit and immediately provided active and visible oversight effectively cultivating a climate of inclusion, excellence, and mission accomplishment.

Prior to assuming his current role, Chief Roth served as the 193d Special Operations Wing Mission Support Group Senior Enlisted Leader, Middletown, Pennsylvania.
