### COLONEL BARBRA S. BULS

Colonel Barbra S. Buls is the Vice Commander, Air National Guard Readiness Center and Commander, 201st Mission Support Squadron, Joint Base Andrews. As the Vice Commander, she assists the Director, Air National Guard in formulating all plans, policies, programs, and execution of the ANG's more than \$9B annual appropriation to enable mission readiness of 105,700 military and civilian personnel in 90 wings throughout the United States, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam and the Virgin Islands. As the Commander, 201st Mission Support Squadron, she exercises elements of command and control over Air National Guard assigned units and members. She is the Title 10 chain of command for ANG members serving on Title 10 orders worldwide.

Colonel Buls enlisted in the South Dakota Air National Guard in 1986 attaining the rank of Staff Sergeant. She was commissioned in 1992 through the Air National Guard Academy of Military Science. Colonel Buls is a senior aircraft maintenance officer with more than 20 years of experience in KC-135 and F-16 maintenance organizations. She has served in major USAF operations including Operation PROVIDE COMFORT/NORTHERN WATCH, SOUTHERN WATCH, ENDURING FREEDOM, NOBLE EAGLE, FREEDOM'S SENTINEL and Operation INHERENT RESOLVE.

Colonel Buls has served in various operational and staff assignments. She commanded both the 155th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron and the 155th Maintenance Group, Nebraska Air National Guard, where she was responsible for maintenance programs and personnel in support of KC-135 aircraft missions. She completed a joint assignment as the Air National Guard Advisor to the Commander, United States Strategic Command, Offutt AFB Nebraska. Her previous staff assignments include Director, Human Resources, and Principal Deputy Director, A4 Logistics and Installations, at the Air National Guard Readiness Center, National Guard Bureau. Her civilian experience includes more than 20 years of executive leadership and management in the health insurance industry and certification as a Six Sigma Black Belt.
