COLONEL KEITH G. MACDONALD

Col. Keith G. MacDonald is the Vice Commander, Air National Guard Readiness Center, and Commander (ANGRC), 201st Mission Support Squadron, Joint Base Andrews, Maryland. As the Vice Commander, he assists the Director, Air National Guard in formulating all plans, policies, programs, and execution of the ANG's more than \$10 billion annual appropriation to enable mission readiness of 105,700 Air National Guard military and civilian personnel in 90 Wings throughout the 50 states, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam and the Virgin Islands. As the 201st Commander, he exercises elements of command and control over Air National Guard assigned units and members. He is the Title 10 chain of command for ANG members serving on Title 10 orders.

Col. MacDonald was commissioned in 1991 as a distinguished graduate from the Reserve Officer Training Corps program at Miami University of Ohio. Following undergraduate pilot training where he was a distinguished graduate in 1993, he served on active duty for nine years flying the A-10 Thunderbolt II aircraft. Col. MacDonald joined the Air National Guard in 2001, where he flew the A-10 as an instructor and combat search and rescue pilot. He served in the U.S. Central Command Joint Operations Center J3 during Operation Enduring Freedom. He has also flown combat sorties in operations Iraqi Freedom and Enduring Freedom.



Col. MacDonald has served in various operational and staff assignments. He served as 113th Maintenance Group Commander in the District of Columbia Air National Guard, where he was responsible for more than 650 personnel supporting F-16, C-38 and C-40 aircraft missions. He served in a joint assignment as Senior Policy Development Analyst, Homeland Defense & Americas' Security Affairs, Office of Secretary of Defense. He has also served as the National Guard Bureau Joint Staff, Chief, Current Operations Division as the NGB Chief of Current Operations. Prior to his current position, Col. MacDonald served as the NGB Director of Logistics and Installations, ANGRC, JB Andrews, Maryland.
