COLONEL MICHAEL J. OLIVER

Colonel Michael J. Oliver is the Deputy Commander, Air National Guard Readiness Center, Joint Base Andrews, Maryland. He is responsible for assisting the Air National Guard Readiness Center Commander with resourcing, oversight, guidance and execution of a more than \$13.7 billion annual appropriation to enable mission readiness of 123,000 military and civilian personnel in 90 wings throughout the United States, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam and the Virgin Islands. Colonel Oliver is dual-hatted as the Commander of the 201st Mission Support Squadron. In this role, he exercises command and control over Air National Guard assigned units and members. He is the Title 10 commander for more than 4,000 Air National Guard members serving on Title 10 orders worldwide.

Colonel Oliver received his commission in March 2000 from the Air National Guard Academy of Military Science, followed by assignments in the logistics readiness and aircraft maintenance career fields. He has commanded at the deputy wing, group, squadron, and flight levels, and he also served as the Retrograde Division Chief, U.S. Central Command Deployment and Distribution Operations Center, Southwest Asia. Prior to his current position, the colonel was assigned as the Air National Guard Advisor to the Headquarters Air Force Director of Logistics (AF/A4L) at the Pentagon, Arlington, VA.
