**Position Description (Duty Description):** Manages the capability requirements definition, acquisition, financial aspects, technical evolution, fielding, sustainment, and focus on operational requirements for advanced electronic warfare and cyberspace applications within the ANG's modernization programs. Directly responsible for: integrating advanced electronic warfare and cyber capabilities across multiple platforms, including manned/unmanned systems; coordinating programs with Air Force Research Lab (AFRL) and Naval Research Lab

(NRL) personnel; managing the annual allocation of National Guard and Reserve Equipment Account (NGREA) resources along with budgeted Air Force funding; addressing critical capability/equipment shortfalls identified by warfighters at the annual Weapons and Tactics Conference (WEPTAC), and at the Domestic Capability Priorities (DCP) Conference; and other duties as directed. Develops acquisition, fielding, and sustainment plans in concert with System Program Offices (SPO), and represents NGB/A5 at HQ USAF, MAJCOMs, and field units to integrate, document, validate, fund, procure, and deliver equipment for, but not limited to, ANG operational portfolios. This position requires well-honed written and verbal communication skills. Knowledge of the Joint Capabilities Integration and Development System (JCIDS), Operational Test and Evaluation (OT&E) processes, Defense Acquisition System (DAS), Planning, Programming, Budgeting and Execution (PPBE) process, and familiarity with the staffing processes at the National Guard Bureau, HQ USAF, MAJCOMs, State/unit levels are a plus. Previous operational or test experience, especially in cyber or electronic warfare applications, is highly desired.

The individual will work with the Air National Guard and Air Force Reserve Test Center (AATC) to develop strategies for evaluating, integrating and fielding advanced electronic capabilities across the Guard's various missions. Coordinates with multiple agencies at the National Guard Bureau and across the Services to determine accountability and authorization. Develops acquisition plans to include producing contract packages. Tracks delivery, verifies invoices and ensures quality control.

The individual will use their operational background to analyze capability gaps in the ANG forces and craft the strategic spending plans to optimize the investments in ANG cyberspace and electronic warfare modernization programs. The individual needs to demonstrate matured military judgment across all facets of applying air power overseas and domestically. Forward thinking, comprehensive understanding of operations, understanding of the relationship between the ANG and the active duty Air Force, and understanding of the functions of the NGB are all attributes a candidate should possess.

Must have a current security clearance and be eligible for T/S SCI.
