Position Description (Duty Description):

AFNORTH/Det 1 Mission: Continental NORAD Region, First Air Force, Air Forces Northern (CONR-1AF-AFNORTH) is seeking qualified 1N0 members to support the mission of the Canadian NORAD Region and provide aerospace surveillance, identification, control and warning for the defense of Canada and North America.

Provide intelligence support to Canadian NORAD Region (CANR) Headquarters (CANR HQ) and intelligence support to Canada Air Defense in accordance with National air defense pacts, to produce synergies in air defense intelligence by co-located and bi-national threat analysis. Support intelligence and air planning with the Canadian military. Provide timely and effective intelligence necessary for Canadian NORAD Region (CANR) to prepare for, plan and conduct air sovereignty, deterrence, and aerospace defense operations. Draw upon the full-spectrum of allied, NORAD and national intelligence agencies to contribute to the overall formulation of CANR intelligence assessments. In accordance with CONPLAN 3310-17, provide intelligence support to CANR using the full range of allied systems with information from all available national intelligence agencies. Intelligence functions include support to Collection Management, Analysis, Dissemination in the 24/7 Canadian Aerospace Operations Center.

The primary function for U.S. Intelligence personnel assigned to support the Canadian NORAD Region is to provide Intelligence expertise in the supported areas as well as provide releasable classified materials relevant to the NORAD mission that are available on U.S. Only classified systems. This important link between HQ NORAD and CANR requires analysts to be available 24/7 to provide time sensitive documents and assessments to CANR senior leadership to enable informed decisions for the defense of North America. Provide access US intelligence community information to meet the 24 hour hours per day 365 days per year mission requirement to fulfill all CONPLAN 3310-17 tasks.

Support the Canadian Aerospace Operations Center's mission and CANR's collection requirements. Manage all RCAF airborne intelligence collection requirements for all Allied and Canadian Armed Forces Components/Elements and utilize all levels and sources of Canadian and Allied collection and reporting to provide strategic, operational and tactical level analysis covering global operations. Provide CANR leadership with detailed Strategic and Operational understanding of adversary intent and capabilities. Perform Analysis, Correlations, and Fusion to directly support global planning efforts.

** All personnel applying for this 1AF (AFNORTH) position must have a current TS security clearance with a SSBI. Additionally members must complete country clearance prior to assignment to Detachment 1.
