Position Description (Duty Description):

EADS, 224th ADS/DOI Mission:

The 224th Air Defense Squadron, Directorate of Intelligence (DOI) is seeking qualified 14N officers and 1NX enlisted members for a one (1) year tour at the Eastern Air Defense Sector. EADS mission is to counter all air threats to EADS' assigned Area of Operations through vigilant detection, rapid warning, and precise tactical control of NORAD forces. EADS directs Air Force capabilities in support of homeland security, VIP travel, and airspace continuity. DOI provides actionable indications and warnings and threat

analysis on strategic and asymmetric threats to enhance situational awareness, facilitate mission planning, and execute assigned missions. DOI routinely coordinates with the Western Air Defense Sector, 601st Air and Space Operations Center, and North American Aerospace Defense Command (NORAD) to identify potential enemy courses of action and support NORAD mission sets. DOI prepares and presents tailored, time sensitive intelligence threat updates, reports, threat analysis, and situation briefings for commanders and operations personnel

Intelligence Operations Analyst, 224th Air Defense Squadron, EADS:

Duties and Qualifications:

The Intelligence Operations Analyst is responsible for day-to-day intelligence support to aerospace defense operations in the NORAD AOR. The analyst coordinates all intelligence reference materials and geospatial services with the weapons and tactics, training, and standards and evaluations offices. The applicant will furnish relevant threat data, imagery products, and charts for mission planning. The member will provide analytical expertise and threat assessments of emerging asymmetric, strategic, and non-traditional weapon systems.
