Position Description (Duty Description):

AFRCC Mission: The AFRCC operates 24/7, serving as the single agency responsible for coordinating on-land routine civil/federal search and rescue (SAR) activities in the 48 contiguous United States. The AFRCC also assists civil SAR in Mexico and Canada as requested. Finally, the AFRCC assists the Joint Personnel Recovery Cell (JPRC) with catastrophic incident SAR (CISAR).

SAR Controller/Senior Controller: Controllers are responsible for all aspects of managing civil search and rescue incidents/missions with life-or-death implications. This includes but is not limited to monitoring communications systems, investigating possible distress situations, coordinating with DoD, US Coast Guard, National Park Service, state, local, and international partners, and applying time management skills to balance multiple incidents at one time. The Senior Controller is responsible to the Director of Operations for overall mission accomplishment by managing the allocation and execution of responsibilities among the SAR controllers on duty. Controllers will maintain situational awareness of all active AFRCC incidents and missions, with the ability to brief AFRCC command section and senior leadership on the status of AFRCC operations.
