- Position Description (Duty Description):**
- A. Assists Chief, 201st MSS ADCON and ANGRC Administrative Law in providing legal advice to the Chief Counsel, the ANG, and Wing JAs on full spectrum legal support on military personnel and administrative law matters at the ANGRC
 - B. Provides legal advice, opinions, and assistance on military personnel and administrative law issues.
 - Advises NGB officials, JAs in 54 states/territories on benefits, recruitment, separations, promotion, and retirements.
 - Reviews, briefs, advises and coordinates on personnel policy changes impacting ANG, Federal and state partnerships.
 - Advises 201 MSS/CC, ANGRC/CC on UCMJ matters; coordinating ANG discipline with Regular AF legal offices
 - C. Accomplishes Reports, Briefings, and Presentations. Collects, analyzes, and evaluates a variety of data; summarizes, and presents findings in the form of reports, recommendations, and briefings to senior staff officials in formulating command level decisions. Presentations must exhibit sound technical judgment, conclusions, and recommendations
 - D. Performs other duties as assigned

A Bachelor of Law or Juris Doctor degree or equivalent awarded by an ABA-accredited law school and admission to the bar of a federal court or the highest court of a state is mandatory. Designation by the Judge Advocate General, USAF, as a judge advocate is required. Prior experience at the State Headquarters level and/or as an AGR is highly desired. This positions requires the expertise of the National Guard judge advocate to understand the nuances of T32, T10 and State Active Duty.
