Position Description (Duty Description): Serves as a Legal Advisor to the Combat Operations Division, 601st Air Operations Center (601 AOC), and the C/JFACC for CONR-1AF AFNORTH, in the following operational areas: (1) the 601 AOC plans, directs, and assesses air and space operations for NORAD and USNORTHCOM and provides aerospace warning and control for NORAD Defensive Counter Air activities; and (2) the 601 AOC directs air and space capabilities in support of USNORTHCOM homeland security and civil support missions, including Defense Support of Civil

Authorities (DSCA) operations during natural or man-made disasters and the Air Force Rescue Coordination Center, the single agency responsible for coordinating on-land federal searches. This position involves shift work. Applicant must be a licensed attorney in good standing. Experience in operations law at the Combined Air Operations Center (CAOC) level, familiarity with domestic operations law, and a firm grasp of National Guard and Total Force Integration issues are highly desirable, but not mandatory.
