Position Description (Duty Description): Incumbent provides comprehensive insight into global availability of ANG military forces/capabilities and provides senior decision makers a process to quickly and accurately assess impact and risk of proposed changes in force/capability assignments, apportionment, and allocation. Incumbent provides advice and assistance to ANG FAMs and other organizations including MAJCOMS, Joint Staff, and other operating agencies. Studies and analyzes problems, or actual operations, while reviewing and advising on policies, procedures, and mission objectives with higher levels of management on the feasibility of different approaches, providing a basis for better planning of operations. Incumbent will conduct feasibility studies to assess Air National Guard capability to support plan requirements by using Total Force Assessment/Equivalent (TFA/TFE), Joint Operational Planning and Execution system/Deliberate Crisis Action planning and Executive Segments

(JOPES/DCAPES) Systems, Defense Readiness Reporting System (DRRS), and Joint Capabilities Requirements Manager (JCRM).

Ensures ANG UTC Functional Area Managers (FAMs) are aware of the War and Mobilization Plan (WMP) and OPLAN tasking requirements and provides/defines OPLAN requirements. Ensures studies and analysis are conducted to improve such areas as operations, weapons, weapon systems, strategy/tactics, cyber net, and training and furnishes data for higher level decisions.

Incumbent will engage in the development of the ANG deliberate/contingency planning process between Joint Staff, HQ USAF, MAJCOMs and the ANG. Reviews, coordinates, and updates OPLAN data from JOPES/DCAPES systems. Ensures messages are reviewed and comply with Combatant Commanders, AF, Force Providers and MAJCOM planner communities, as well as operations plans and contingency plans data. Incumbent serves as an authority/consultant to other organizations, MAJCOMs, and agencies in assigned areas of responsibility. Additionally, represents the organization on DOD working groups, steering groups, or other meetings, conferences, or seminars. Incumbent will host meetings with MAJCOM representatives to discuss/resolve controversial operational/planning concepts and other issues of common interest.
