equities in the development of AF Security Forces programmatic and scheduling decisions. The ANG is unique in how the legalities of jurisdiction and United States Title Code effect the enterprise. Responsibilities include (but are not limited to) the following: Interface with NGB/A4S Division Managers and Air Force Security Forces Center (AFSFC) staff with regard to Security Forces requirements and resources capabilities and limitations; Coordinate between A4S and the AFSFC in the areas of training, weapons systems, and equipment procurement; Interface with AFSFC regarding ANG requirements for future growth and emerging technologies; Review HAF/A4S policy and strategic plans and assist the AFSFC in incorporating ANG-specific requirements in programmatic objectives to meet policy driven requirements; Represent NGB/A4S regarding unit capabilities and capacity with Electronic Security Systems (ESS); Respond to questions or concerns related to contractual procurements. Represent ANG equities in installation base defense security systems. Coordinate with NGB/A4S and AFSFC training scheduling effecting ANG Security Forces deployment and sustainment requirements
