Position Description (Duty Description): NGB/A4O requires a Senior Project Manager capable of developing and managing assigned programs based upon current needs of the A4O organization and providing an enterprise-wide perspective in support of MILCON/SRM program execution. As a senior project manager you will be responsible for managing all facets of MILCON/SRM execution by ensuring assigned projects are appropriately approve for design and/or construction. Additionally, provide guidance, as required, to other project managers in

coordinating with BCE personnel, USP&FO's, A-E firms and installation senior leadership (e.g. be able to proficiently conduct BRC/CRCs, advance submittal briefings to peers.) Develop and advocate improvements to NGB design and construction policy and standards for all types of facility projects utilizing formal engineering education, experience and technical expertise. Clearly explain and uphold the six (6) ANG MILCON and Major SRM project design goals of Flexibility, Sustainability, Compatibility, Conformance with Energy Policy, AT/FP Compliance and Maintainability. Documenting our policy, processes and procedures in the form of ANG Instructions and Engineering Technical letters as needed and assigned.

Provides professional engineer/architectural consultation on a broad range of difficult technical issues and problem resolutions. Analyzes options for the execution of ANG design and construction projects, recommends preferred options ensuring compliance with the objectives of the ANG construction program. Responsible for the design of all MILCON projects (PB, ADD or P-341) such that the projects have a complete approved Type A2 design by September 2 years prior to its year of appropriation (FY-2). Validate requests for additional design funds and funding for emergency projects and change orders. Keep project information up-to-date, accurate and complete in PDS. Complete project close-out within 3 years of Beneficial Occupancy. Represent A4O at internal meetings and external conferences and training events.
