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**Position Description (Duty Description):** Incumbent will perform as an NGB/A8XC action officer and be responsible for the preparation, validation, and distribution of Air National Guard Strategic Planning documents, to include flight-plans, and white papers, as approved and directed by the Director, Air National

Guard. Additionally, the incumbent will assist in developing the ANG position on these documents and coordinate ANG position with Headquarters Air Force and Air Force Major Commands. Will also serve as an advisor to Air National Guard senior staff and leadership in determining the most appropriate response in the areas of ANG strategic and long range plans. Will be expected to conduct meetings with various key personnel within the Air National Guard and outside agencies in order to discuss, evaluate, and determine courses of action relative to strategic planning, force structure analyses and other long range plans. Must be able to analyze logically and objectively, and apply sound judgment in assessing possible solutions, and adjust to changing priorities. Must have a working knowledge of the functions and organization structure of the NGB, USAF, MAJCOMs, NAFs, TAGs, and ANG units.
