Position Description (Duty Description):

Performs Functional Area Manager (FAM) responsibilities for the ANG Unit Level Intelligence (ULI) mission set as proscribed in AFI 10-401, *Air Force Operations Planning and Execution*, Chapter 12 – The Functional Area Manager. Responsibilities include the following:

- Responds to questions/concerns from ANG Unit Level Intelligence Senior Intelligence Officers, Superintendents, and/or squadron commanders regarding organize, train and equip (OT&E) issues
- Serves primary POC regarding ULI capabilities, capacity, and force posturing
- Develops and reviews ULI specific policy and plans
- Tracks IOC/FOC milestones for ANG ULI units in conversion until they achieve FOC
- Assists/facilitates unit requests for staff assistance visits (SAVs) prior to inspections
- Monitors ANG unit level intelligence personnel ability to meet AF Inspection Systems requirements; includes reviewing unit Management Internal Control Toolset (MICT) Self-Assessment Communicators (SACs), tracking progress, and reconciling inspection deficiencies entered in the IG Evaluation Management System (IGEMS)

- Develops, manages and maintains Designed Operational Capability (DOC) statements, Unit Type Codes (UTCs), and Unit Manning Documents (UMDs); develops ULI-specific criteria for, and monitoring of, DoD, and AF readiness reporting (ART, DRRS, AFIT)
- Verifies, staffs, and monitors activation (mobilization) of ANG personnel and units called to active duty
- Works with ANG Enlisted Intelligence Career Field Functional Manager and ANG Intelligence Training Manager to obtain formal training and MDS specific allocations for ANG ULI personnel
- Represents ANG ULI community at Headquarters, Air Force, and MAJCOM specific intelligence planning workshops and conferences
- Assists the NGB/A2/3/6/10I Program Element Monitor (PEM) develop planning, programming, budgeting and execution (PPBE) actions for the ANG ULI units

REQUIRED: TS/SCI and experience in intelligence operations/support.

Common Questions:

Q: If selected how does the state cut my orders over the FY?

A: FM POC: If the intent of the order is over 180 days – TDY with PCS entitlements - then the order should be cut for the entire period with the following on the order. "Authorizations to cite the next fiscal year does not constitute authorizations to obligate funds until approved by Congress"

Q: Can I be promoted while on an ADOS tour?

A. POC A1. Yes. Airman are TDY to these locations and still assigned to the state. Promotion action would be processed through the STATE.

Q: Do I receive an Evaluation for the ADOS tour?

A: POC A1. No. Airman are assigned to the state during this TDY / with PCS Entitlements and may receive an LOE. The State is still responsible for any Evaluations that close out during this timeframe.

Q: Is this a PCS?

A: POC: FM –A tour over 180 days receives "PCS entitlements." This includes movement of household goods and DEERS associated Family members. Airman and Family must meet all medical qualifications if the location requires.

Q: Is there an API code associated with the tour?

A: POC A1: No. Airman are still assigned to their State. There is not a Unit Manning Document Position assigned to ADOS tours.

Q: Do I out process my Base?

A: Airman must utilize the unit and base out processing for a TDY.
