## 1. Requirements

Must hold rank/grade, AFSC requirement, and be current/passing within fitness standards as established by AFI 36-2905, by and through announcement closeout date. All information must be accurately indicated on the vMPF RIP at the time of application.

Must have or be able to obtain a TS/SCI (Top Secret/Sensitive Compartmented Information) security clearance.

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## 2. Position Description

**QUALIFICATIONS OR KNOWLEDGE:** Incumbent should have significant AF ISR operations experience. Should be thoroughly familiar with all governing directives and policies pertaining to AF enlisted intelligence career fields. Knowledge of the functions/organizational structure of the NGB/ANGRC staff, AF, MAJCOMs and NAFs, and the States/Territories is mandatory. Familiarity with staff procedures and actions including manpower, and planning, programming, budgeting, and execution (PPBE) processes is desired. Should possess excellent technical writing and briefing skills. Must possess or be eligible for a Top Secret, Sensitive Compartmented Information (SCI) clearance.

**ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES, AND DUTIES:**

Advises the Deputy Director of ANG Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance (ISR) Operations, Director of ANG Operations (NGB/A2/3/6/10), ANGRC/CC, and ANG Unit Commanders and Superintendents on enlisted intelligence matters. (DoDD 5100.01, DoDD 5105.77, DoDD 5240.01, AFI 14-202V1, AFPD 14-202) Responsible for career field functional management of all ANG enlisted intelligence AF Specialties. Oversees all enlisted intelligence formal training allocations; ensures ANG enlisted intelligence formal training requirements are included in ANG PPBE actions. Coordinates on all ANG, gaining MAJCOM, HAF and Joint documents related to ANG enlisted intelligence personnel, units, and missions. (DoDI 3305.02, JP 1-03.3, AFI 10-201, AFI 10-244, AFI 10-403, AFI 14-202V1, AFPD 10-2, AFPD 10-4, AFPD 14-202) Oversees the ANG enlisted portion of the AF's intelligence training program, to include initial qualification, mission qualification, and continuation training standards per each applicable Mission Design Series (MDS) and training/certification requirements for specific intelligence AF Specialties and positions. Ensures DoD- and AF-required enlisted intelligence initial/mission qualification training requirements are included in the PPBE as appropriate. (DoDD 7730.65, DoDI 3305.02, DoDI 3305.09, DoDI 3305.10, DoDI 3305.16, AFI 10-201, AFI 10-244, AFI 10-403, AFI 14-117, AFI 14-124, AFI 14-125, AFI 14-126, AFI 14-202V1, AFJI 14-107, AFPD 10-2, AFPD 10-4, AFPD 14-202) Participates in the development of AF intelligence Career Field Education and Training Plans (CFETP), and ensures their implementation and maintenance throughout the ANG. Attends - or ensures appropriate ANG subject matter expert(s) attends - Utilization and Training Workshops (U&TW) and Speciality Training Requirements Team (STRT) meetings as required. (AFI 36-2201, AFPD 14-202)

-Directs implementation of the AF Intelligence Career Development Courses (CDCs) within the ANG. Reviews CDCs for accuracy and initiates actions to develop new/revised CDCs to meet new requirements and delete obsolete requirements. (AFI 36-2201, AFPD 14-202) Monitors unit compliance with DoD, AF, and ANG enlisted intelligence training and force management policy; if discrepancies discovered, recommends corrective actions to ensure unit compliance. (DoDD 5100.01, DoDD 5105.77, AFPD 14-202) Represents the ANG at National Intelligence Community, DoD, HAF, MAJCOM, and COCOM-level planning workshops, conferences, and other forums. Advises all levels of AF and joint commands on ANG enlisted intelligence capabilities and training requirements for incorporation into mission plans and activities. (DoDD 5100.01, DoDD 5105.77, AFPD 14-202) Provides enlisted training/career field management-related briefings, papers, and other information as required. Accomplishes assigned taskers via the designated ANGRC task management system. (DoDD 5100.01, DoDD 5105.77, AFI 10-401)

-As directed, fills ANG position in the NGCC during real-world or exercise situations. (DoDD 5100.01, DoDD 5105.77)

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### **3. Application Reminders**

**Promotion Opportunity:** If this Military Vacancy Announcement is a promotion opportunity and you are currently assigned to a Special Duty Identifier (SDI), you must meet the promotion requirements as outlined in AFI 36-2502.

Applicants who are in a higher grade than the grade for this advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with your application stating you are willing to be voluntarily demoted without prejudice if selected for this position, IAW AFI 36-2502. If selected for this vacancy, voluntary demotion action must take place prior to being assessed to the Statutory Tour Program.

Pen/ink changes to any source document, i.e. Report on Individual Personnel (RIP), evaluations, etc. could result in disapproval.

It is your responsibility to ensure your vMPF RIP is accurate/in order prior to application submittal. This includes but not limited to, verifying duty history, AFSC, service dates and ensuring overdue TDY codes are cleared.

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### **4. About Statutory Tours**

This is a fully funded Permanent Change of Station (PCS). Visit DFAS website for most current Basic Allowance Housing (BAH) & Basic Allowance Substance (BAS) rates for the duty location listed on this announcement.

All Members assigned to the Statutory Tour program will remain affiliated their state/territory while serving on Statutory Tour.

All field members to include AGR, Technicians, Drill Status Guardsmen, ANG members assigned to NGB as a State Candidate, and ANG members assigned to NGB utilizing a state resource, must obtain and submit State TAG approval with application. Members currently assigned to the Statutory Tour program (excludes State Candidates and members assigned to NGB utilizing a state resource) must obtain current director's approval.

Statutory Tour members may be eligible for the Post 9/11 GI Bill if they serve on active duty Title 10 and/or Title 32 502(f) AGR for 90 days or more, after 11 September 2001. Their eligibility percentage starts at 40% for 90 days to 5 months. It increases 10% every 6 months, maxing out at 100%.

Statutory Tour service time does not count toward reduced eligibility age for reserve retirement pay.
