1. Requirements

Must hold rank/grade, AFSC requirement, and be current/passing within fitness standards as established by AFI 36-2905, by and through announcement closeout date. All information must be accurately indicated on the vMPF RIP at the time of application.

Must have a TS/SCI (Top Secret/Sensitive Compartmented Information) security clearance.

2. Position Description

-Should have knowledge in: emergency management to include National Incident Management System (NIMS) and AF Incident Management System (AFIMS); processing operational reports; aircraft mission monitoring; maintaining physical security; using encode/decode methods; operating communications systems, automated data processing equipment, and C2 information processing equipment; using time/location reference systems; translating/ disseminating weather information; conducting briefings; maintaining CP displays/logs; and overall Air Force organization and administration.

ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES, AND DUTIES

This position is considered “essential personnel” and is subject to rotating shifts and maintains an “on-call” status 24/7, 365 days a year. The incumbent is required to maintain standards and perform all Command and Control Technician responsibilities to include initial refresher training upon assignment and mandatory monthly recurring training requirements (formal training, self study, and proficiency training). This position validates and processes Emergency Action Messages (EAMs) and coordinates message applicability with AF and various MAJCOMs; processes international treaty compliance information messages; briefs NGB/ANG senior leadership and recommends course of action to various scenarios; provides operational support to NGB/ANG senior leadership; composes, sends, and receives messages providing connectivity to, and interoperability with, other government agencies and other approved activities; processes ANG aircraft incident/accident reports through AFOREPS and coordinates with applicable units to acquire all information pertaining to the event/incident; interfaces with appropriate MAJCOMs, HQ USAF, and the NMCC to disseminate collected data and assists units in the preparation of reports to meet USMTF requirements; initiates and accomplishes reporting requirements for field units without continuous command and control capability and screens all AFOREPS to ensure compliance with USMTF procedures; reviews all ANG wing SITREPs for data pertaining to OPREP-3's or any event/incident deemed to be of interest to the Director, ANG; provides an overview of significant occurrences involving or affecting ANG assets through a daily events log; provides a 24-hour snapshot of ANG activities to the NGB/ANG senior leadership, higher headquarters, MAJCOMs and field units via the ANG OPSUM; manages all elements of ANG mission monitoring through the Global Decision Support System (GDSS II); validates and issues mission numbers for various deployments; initiates recall checklists and activates the CAT upon direction by the Director, ANG; supports the CAT in data collection, dissemination and mobilization of ANG assets; monitors communications and message traffic between ANG units, Sectors (EADS and WADS), CONR, NORAD, NORTHCOM, and HQ Air Force;

provides secure telecommunications with reliable, secure, interoperable C2 and crisis management capabilities in support of the CJCS Emergency Action Messages, AF Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP), NGB COOP, and the ANG CAT through the Defense Red Switch Network (DRSN) supporting communications and flow of information between the NGB/ANG senior leadership, MAJCOMs, AF, and the NMCC. Provides fast, reliable, and total automation of notification procedures to the NGB/ANG senior leadership, such as recalls, exercises, and escalations through an Emergency Management System (EMS) during routine operations, emergencies, contingencies, and increased readiness; monitors the security for the ANG Readiness Center through the various security and closed-circuit camera systems; other duties as assigned by the Chief, Command and Control Branch.

3. Application Reminders

Promotion Opportunity: If this Military Vacancy Announcement is a promotion opportunity and you are currently assigned to a Special Duty Identifier (SDI), you must meet the promotion requirements as outlined in AFI 36-2502.

Applicants who are in a higher grade than the grade for this advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with your application stating you are willing to be voluntarily demoted without prejudice if selected for this position, IAW AFI 36-2502. If selected for this vacancy, voluntary demotion action must take place prior to being assessed to the Statutory Tour Program.

Pen/ink changes to any source document, i.e. Report on Individual Personnel (RIP), evaluations, etc. could result in disapproval.

It is your responsibility to ensure your vMPF RIP is accurate/in order prior to application submittal. This includes but not limited to, verifying duty history, AFSC, service dates and ensuring overdue TDY codes are cleared.

4. About Statutory Tours

This is a fully funded Permanent Change of Station (PCS). Visit DFAS website for most current Basic Allowance Housing (BAH) & Basic Allowance Substance (BAS) rates for the duty location listed on this announcement.

All Members assigned to the Statutory Tour program will remain affiliated their state/territory while serving on Statutory Tour.

All field members to include AGR, Technicians, Drill Status Guardsmen, ANG members assigned to NGB as a State Candidate, and ANG members assigned to NGB utilizing a state resource, must obtain and submit State TAG approval with application. Members currently assigned to the Statutory Tour program (excludes State Candidates and members assigned to NGB utilizing a state resource) must obtain current director's approval.

Statutory Tour members may be eligible for the Post 9/11 GI Bill if they serve on active duty Title 10 and/or Title 32 502(f) AGR for 90 days or more, after 11 September 2001. Their eligibility percentage starts at 40% for 90 days to 5 months. It increases 10% every 6 months, maxing out at 100%.

Statutory Tour service time does not count toward reduced eligibility age for reserve retirement pay.

Further information regarding the Statutory Tour Program can be found in ANGI 36-6.

Application packages will be reviewed to ensure qualifications are met. Packages are reviewed within four duty-days of receipt.
