Description The 48 MDG is seeking a 48R3, fully qualified flight surgeon, for manning assistance due to a shortage in this AFSC. This flight surgeon will provide the full functional duties such as flight physicals (both initial and renewal), flight waivers, flight PHAs, and other flight medicine support. The flight surgeon will also provide support for pilots and those on flying status for medical conditions and treatment. In addition, the flight surgeon will assist with occupational health exams for both base fire and other base support entities. The flight surgeon will support medical and flying operations for the Tri-base area of RAF Lakenheath, Mildenhall and Feltwell, as well as provide support to the 501st Combat Support Wing in the UK. Minimum qualifications are an Aerospace Medicine Primary (AMP) trained physician who is fully qualified as a flight surgeon. A Residency in Aerospace Medicine (RAM) flight surgeon is optimal, but not required
